

**ISRAEL 101**  
**Part 14**  
**“The Second Passover”**

Let's open the word of Yahweh this morning. We're going to Hosea chapter 2. This is part 14 of Israel 101. We've been talking about who Israel is and who Israel is not. An Israelite is simply an overcomer. No one will be in Remnant Israel who is not an overcomer. No one. It doesn't matter if you're part of the lost tribes. You must come through Remnant Israel. And only those who overcome sin will be an Israelite.

Who was the first Israelite? *Jacob*. And why was he called Israel? *Because he wrestled with God and man and overcame*. Amen. He overcame himself. He overcame his pride. He overcame his own agenda and submitted to the will of Yahweh for his life. Now we must do the same thing.

The book of Hosea is a book about the lost tribes of Israel. When you read the book of Hosea, remember you're not reading about the Jewish people. That's one of the biggest things that you will have to get out of your mind is that it's to the Jews. No. Most of the prophets—Jeremiah, Hosea, Micah, Amos, all of the prophets were the majority speaking to you the lost tribes of the house of Israel.

So we're going to pick up now in Hosea 2:14. I want to clear up a few misunderstandings that people have. Let's read.

**Hosea 2:14-17**

**14 Therefore, behold, I will allure her, and bring her into the wilderness, and speak comfortably unto her.**

Who is her? Israel, Gomer, Ghomri. Everyone who is part of Gomer the adulteress wife. He said, in the previous verses, I'm going to have no mercy on her. And now here he is saying, therefore I will entice her. Now how is he going to entice Israel? He's going to bring her into the wilderness. The Hebrew word for allure is *pathah* and it just means entice her.

Now Yahweh is going to entice Israel but he's going to do something before he entices her. What is he going to do to her? He's going to bring her into the wilderness. Do you know what that means brothers and sisters? He will not be bringing her back to the holy land. He is going to deal with her where? In the wilderness.

I've got news for you. Israel are the people who will not be in Israel. Ha, ha, ha. I don't know if that's going to make any sense to you. I'll try to make it make sense. *Scattered*. Israel—they put the wrong name on the land of Judea. They should've named it the state of Judah. But they named it Israel and it was a seductive name. And the only people who aren't there is Israel, alright?

Why is that? Because Israel is dealt with in the wilderness outside of the holy land. Hallelujah. And that is where he is going to speak to her. It's very important that you understand that God deals with Israel in the wilderness. Where is the wilderness? The wilderness is the same as it was in the Old Testament. It was not in the promised land. Now let's read verse 15.

**15 And I will give her her vineyards from that place, and the valley of Achor for a door of hope, and she shall sing there, as in the days of her youth, and as in the day when she came up out of the land of Egypt.**

So the wilderness is not the promised land, but yet we're told that Gomer, Israel, is going to sing and dance and rejoice from the wilderness. That is where Yahweh is going to deal with the lost tribes of Israel—outside of the “promised land” just like Israel was to leave Egypt in the first exodus. Does anybody remember where the second exodus happened? *Assyria*. Absolutely correct.

The first exodus was out of Egypt. The second exodus was out of Assyria. Those tribes that left Assyria, where did they go? Into the wilderness. They went outside of where they were until they came to the place where Yahweh is going to make them sing again. That's why the third verse of my song “This is the Gathering of the House of Israel” says the dry bones how they dance and how they sing. Hallelujah. Amen.

Now I want to deal with a verse that a lot of people use to try to prove that Yahweh remarries Israel. We taught you last week that that is impossible. Why can Yahweh not remarry Israel? *It's illegal. It's against Torah*. Amen. It's against Torah. It is illegal totally. So therefore how do the Messianics make up for this? They teach that Yahweh wrapped himself in flesh, came and died, and ended the marriage covenant.

However that violates Torah as well because Yahweh said I'm not a man, neither am I the son of man. And he said I cannot die. I am immutable. I am eternal. So therefore, if that's not the case, we found out that in a marriage covenant, one of the two parties has to die to do what? End that covenant. And we found out that Yahweh did not remarry Israel.

However, when we get to verse 16, it's troubling and here's why. Let's read it.

**16 And it shall be at that day, saith Yahweh, that thou shalt call me Ishi, and shalt call me no more Baali.**

Alright, let me show you why this verse is troubling. Because the Messianics teach that this verse proves that Yahweh is going to remarry Israel because he says in that day you will call me Ishi. Well they say that that word Ishi means husband. And it does. *So therefore, that's the proof pastor Vaughn that you're wrong and they're right because Yahweh says they will call me "husband".*

Well let's find the problem with that. Amen. You have to learn to study the word. You have to learn to study the word with all of your heart and to know what it says and what it means. *So you'll have an understanding.* So you'll have a perfect understanding elder. And without that understanding you'll believe all kinds of things.

Here we are in Hosea 2:16. The word we're struggling with is *Ishi*. And it shall be in that day that you shall call me Ishi (Strong's H376). And brothers and sisters, if somebody's teaching you right now and they say Ishi means husband, you'll sit there and say amen, ok. But let's find out where they get the authority to say that. The first meaning is not husband.

The first meaning is not husband. It's man or men, or one. Do you see the word one? Now husband is only translated 69 times. But let's go down and find the deeper meaning.

An individual. A more definite term. A certain, a champion. As you go through you see the word one over and over. As you get into the root word, go down further, and you see a certain one. You can't just say it means husband. An INDIVIDUAL.

So let's go back now and see what Yahweh is truly saying here. You shall no longer call me Baali (that's the word Baal). You shall no longer know me as a god like Baal. But you shall know me as ONE. You shall know me INDIVIDUALLY. You shall know me PERSONALLY. *Hallelujah, hallelujah.* Amen. It truly is that simple. But they say it means husband. It can mean husband except we know that he cannot marry again. So we have to dig and we find out that it means individual, personal.

In that day, you will no longer know me as Baal. You will no longer know me in that way. You will no longer worship false gods, but you will know me personally,

individually, one-on-one. You will be able to come boldly into the throne room of grace. You will not worship me as the pagans do from afar. You will know me personally. Amen. Oh hallelujah. Verse 17.

**17 For I will take away the names of Baalim out of her mouth, and they shall no more be remembered by their name.**

How will you know that I've allured you? I'll put my name in your mouth individually—individual personal name. You will no longer know me as “God”. *Amen*. Or even “lord” (Baal). You will not know me in that way. You will not know me out of fear. You will not know me out of frustration. I will allure you. You will know me through the covenant of my son Yahshua. You will come boldly before me. I'll take those names out of your mouth.

*This is so powerful. Amen. Oh, we are in that moment elder where he's alluring us. Oh hallelujah. Amen. Get that understanding today. It would be like if I'm in a relationship. Let's say someone's in a relationship with an elder in this church. You know, they've become romantically involved, whatever. All of a sudden that elder—they say, no my name is \_\_\_\_\_ in that intimacy. You will know me from that position. You will know me. I will take those names out of your mouth, those titles. I will take that out of your mouth and I will reveal, I will allure you.*

And that's the day we're all living in. I was 35 years old before I knew the name of my heavenly Father. After being in the church all my life, I knew him not. Truly we are a fatherless church. Fatherless began in the church not the home. But Yahweh is taking those names out of our mouth. Hallelujah. We will know him individually! We will no longer know him as just our owner, but we will have a relationship with him one on one. Amen. Isn't that wonderful to know this morning? Hallelujah. Praise the Lord.

Now let's continue. Let's go to Romans 7:1-4. I want to show you how that your relationship in the Old Covenant has ended. Let's read it.

#### **Romans 7:1-4**

**1 Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law has dominion over a man as long as he lives?**

**2 For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives, but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.**

**3 So then if, while her husband lives, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is**

**free from that law, so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.**

**4 Wherefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law by the body of Christ, that you should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto Yahweh.**

Ok brothers and sisters, you died. Let's read when you died. Let's go to 2 Corinthians 5:16-17. As long as both of you are alive, you and Yahweh, you lost tribes of Israel. As long as you're alive. You're under the Old Covenant, but you're bound into that divorced situation as long as you're alive. It requires your death to free you from being a divorced woman. You can only be free if one of you dies. Let's read when you died.

**2 Corinthians 5:16-17**

**16 Therefore, from now on, we know no man after the flesh, yes, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet from now on we know him no more.**

**17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature, old things have passed away, behold, all things have become new.**

He is a what? *A new creature*. He is what? *A NEW CREATURE*. *Oh the old man's dead*. Come on now. He is totally. You were the old lost tribes of Israel, you were natural descendants of Israel. When you died with Christ, you died a natural Israelite, but you came up remnant Israel, a spiritual Israelite, and therefore that covenant that divorced you has ended. You are no longer married to Yahweh and divorced from Yahweh.

You were a divorced woman until you died. All of a sudden a new girl is born. And now the Bible says that girl can be married to what? To another. Now he tells you who you're married to, or betrothed to. Now it's not Yahweh. It tells you in that verse. Read that last line.

**If any man be in Christ, old things have passed away, behold, all things have become new.**

Now all things have passed away. And it tells us, if you go back to Romans 7:4...

### **Romans 7:4**

**Wherefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law by the body of Christ, that you should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.**

You also became dead to that old covenant through the body of Christ that you might be joined to another. Well who is that other? To him who was raised from the dead! Oh hallelujah! *Hallelujah! Bye bye guilt, hello renewed covenant.* You're no longer the bride of Yahweh. Now you're the bride of Yahshua. To him that was raised—who are you getting married to now? TO HIM THAT WAS RAISED FROM THE DEAD.

You could not marry him as long as you were a divorced wife of Yahweh. So we had to bury that dead, divorced woman, put her in the water. And you became a brand new creature. That didn't happen when you received Christ as your savior. Oh no. The death and burial happens in water baptism. Oh yes. That's where you are raised again to newness of life according to the holy scriptures. Amen?

You're a new creature. That phrase "new creature" means something. It's not just a cute little euphemism. But you're literally buried with Christ. Let's read about that because I think many of us don't understand. Let's read Romans 6:1-6, 14

### **Romans 6:1-6, 14**

**1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?**

**2 Yahweh forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?**

**3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Yahshua Messiah were baptized into his death?**

We died when? When did we die with Christ? In what? Baptism. Not when you said I believe in Christ.

**4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death, that like as Yahshua was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.**

**5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection.**

**6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.**

And that happened in baptism. Now read verse 14.

**14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for ye are not under the law, but under grace.**

Now how are we not under the law? If sin no longer has dominion over us, then we're not breaking the law, therefore, we don't come under the penalty of the law, but we walk in grace which gives us power over sin which keeps us from being under the law. Is anybody hearing me today? I hope so.

You're not under the law brother as long as you're abiding by the speed limit. You'll never come under the law ever. You come under the law when they handcuff you. That's how you come under the law when you break it. Brothers and sisters, the reason you're no longer under the law is you received grace that gave you power over the very thing that kept bringing you under the law. Amen.

*Righteousness has no penalty.* None whatsoever. *Oh thank you Yahweh!* And therefore you never come under that law. You are buried with Christ in baptism, and when you are, then you are a new creature. That's why when people tell me that Yahshua was without sin I say amen. And the reason it confuses them is because they don't understand. The boy who was 30 years old, who was buried in baptism, died. That 30 year old man was wiped out of the very mind of Yahweh.

You see, you all don't believe in baptism the way you should. You don't understand the power of water baptism. You don't understand that Yahshua had to be baptized to fulfill all righteousness the Bible said. He didn't go down there to put on a show. *Oh he just did it as an example.* No, he did it to fulfill the Torah. All righteousness. Why? Because the high priest always washes himself first! And now he was becoming our high priest. When he came out of the water, that boy, that man, Mary's baby, died in the water. He died in the water and John says what came up was — Behold the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world.

That was the first time Yahshua was ever recognized as the lamb of God. That's the first time you'll be recognized as a lamb of God, when you come out of the water! *Pastor, that's when Mary, you know, when the baby was born, they had to offer a sin offering for sinful flesh.* That's right. And they did didn't they? *He wasn't perfect at that time.* The Bible said that he grew in wisdom and understanding and in favor with God and man.



How do you grow in anything if you're already all that? The Bible said he had to learn obedience. Well the opposite of obedience is rebellion. Brothers and sisters, the only thing that matters to God is from that moment of baptism forward.

*Pastor, and so it would also justify the scriptures that attest that Yahshua went to the temple and it was in disobedience because he didn't stay with his family. And when they get back to him and he says "you know I'm doing my Father's business". Everybody's like "oh he's doing God's business". It didn't matter. He still disobeyed his parents. That's correct. And his mother gave two turtle doves as her sin offering when she went to the temple before he was there.*

Absolutely brother, and we have to understand that none of that even matters because before baptism you are not even recognized in the beloved. You're not even recognized as a lamb of Yahweh. This is why on Passover night we will wash your hands, we will wash your feet. We will re-baptize you because lambs must go through this to show that they are the lambs of God.

Brothers and sisters, let me show you what happens. The only time you can put God to an open shame, let's read about it in Hebrews 6:4-6.

#### **Hebrews 6:4-6**

**4 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,**

**5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world (age) to come,**

**6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance, seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.**

The only way that you can put Christ to an open shame is after your baptism, after you have come to the knowledge of the truth. The point I'm making to you... you did not even exist in the mind of God before your baptism. You are a dead man to him. You are not in covenant. You are dead. Brothers and sisters, you need to understand what that means. **YOU ARE A NEW CREATION.** That means what it says. When that man came out of baptism, that was a new creation. Now he was not Mary's boy. He was the lamb of Yahweh.

When you come out of the water, you're no longer mama's baby. You're now one of the lambs of Yahweh. Isn't that wonderful to know? Hallelujah. Thank you Father. Thank you for your word Father. Praise the Lord. Amen. Know how important your baptism was. Know that you came up a new creature. And do you

know what? If you did not understand that, then do it again. You see, here's the deal. Baptism is powerless if you don't understand you're fulfilling all righteousness. If you don't understand do it again. Why? You need to know what you're doing, and you need to come up with faith that I'm a new creature in Christ. Old things, what? Old me has passed away. I went to his funeral.

Every baptism is a funeral. I think we'll start playing funeral music at baptisms. Beulah land, ha, ha, ha! Hallelujah. And then every baptism is what? A resurrection as well. Amen? It's all there and you need to understand. That's why at our church we have everybody come gather around and celebrate what's happening in the water. Amen. Praise God.

Let's go back to Hosea now, where we left off. Hosea 2:21-23.

### **Hosea 2:21-23**

**21 And it shall come to pass in that day, I will hear, saith Yahweh, I will hear the heavens, and they shall hear the earth.**

**22 And the earth shall hear the corn, and the wine, and the oil, and they shall hear Jezreel.**

In that day the whole earth—by the way, the grain is the barley, the wine is the 144,000 and so is the oil. He said in that day the whole earth will respond to the first harvest. You know we just saw the Abib barley in Israel. It's been confirmed. That means that we're coming upon the new year now. Why? Because what always blooms first in Israel? The barley. Now brothers and sisters, Hosea prophesies in that day that the earth, the entire earth, will respond to the barley, the wine, and the oil.

Now isn't that interesting because I believe I read in the book of Revelation that there's a command from Yahweh. In Revelation 6:6, when he's getting ready to pour out his wrath—read it.

### **Revelation 6:6**

**And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny, and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.**

Oh hallelujah. Why did he say that brothers and sisters? Who is the oil? Who is the wine? Who is the barley? Remnant Israel, Jezreel, who has been scattered and sowed, and the entire earth is going to respond to our ministry! *Hallelujah!* Which is what? The ministry of reconciliation!! The whole earth is going to respond to our ministry. I'll show you when that's going to happen. Romans 8:19.

## **Romans 8:19**

**For the earnest expectation of the creature waits for the manifestation of the sons of Yahweh.**

The whole earth is waiting for the barley, the oil and the wine to get it together so that Jezreel, those who were scattered, those who were sown, can arise in the earth and heal the earth with the oil and with the wine. And now you might understand the parable of the good Samaritan. What did he pour into the man laying on the side of the road? The oil and the wine!! Oh that we would understand these things. That man laying on the side of the road was the whole earth. And the oil and the wine was what's going to heal the whole earth. First we had to be scattered and sown. *And who were the Samaritans?* The house of Israel. Remnant Israel.

Alright let's read that verse again now and see if it doesn't finally make sense to you. How many of you have ever read that verse and thought the what? Amen? Now read it again and see if your understanding will open up for you. Now I just want your understanding. I want you to read it now and see what it's saying.

## **Hosea 2:21-23**

**21 And it shall come to pass in that day, I will hear, saith Yahweh, I will hear the heavens, and they shall hear the earth.**

**22 And the earth shall hear the corn, and the wine, and the oil, and they shall hear Jezreel.**

Oh they shall hear Jezreel. What does that mean? Our ministry. They're going to hear our ministry beloved. This is who Israel is. Do you not understand how important you are in the plans of Yahweh? This is the kingdom message. This is what we believe.

We know that one day the whole earth is going to hear us after we have heard the message of the hour. Then we will teach the message of the hour. Oh the beauty of it. The wonder of it. If you ever get it in your heart you'll never be able to walk away from it. If you ever understand who Jezreel is, it will change your life beloved.

You're not part of a church. You're part of a great commission. You're part of a high calling. You're part of something bigger than you. It is this great calling of Jezreel. Hallelujah. Read verse 23.

**23 And I will sow her unto me in the earth...**

Now what does that mean? I, Yahweh, can't come to the earth in it's current condition. I won't come. It's filled with sin. But I will scatter and sow her into the earth on my behalf. I will sow her, this new woman, remnant Israel. I will scatter her first as natural Israel and I'll sow her as remnant Israel. I'll sow her into the earth on my behalf, for myself. She will be mine. Nothing else will be mine, but her.

**...and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy, and I will say to them which were not my people, Thou art my people, and they shall say, Thou art my God Yahweh.**

Did you see the personableness there? You will no longer call me Baali. You will no longer know me as a distant God. You will call me Ishi, an individual God. And here he says what will happen in that day when I will allure you to the wilderness. You were not my people. YOU WERE NOT MY PEOPLE.

Now Paul talks about that. Let's read what he says in Ephesians 2. Here's who he's talking to. Remember Yahweh is talking to the lost tribes, and here is Paul talking to the lost tribes. Ephesians 2:11-12.

**Ephesian 2:11-12**

**11 Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh...**

If there is anyone still identifying in this class as a Gentile, you are out of covenant with Yahweh. There is no such thing as a Gentile Christian. You were lied to. Anyone who's in covenant with Yahweh must be an Israelite. Christians are not in covenant with him. Did you hear me? Christianity is not in covenant with him. Christianity is in covenant with the pope.

**ONLY ISRAEL IS IN COVENANT WITH YAHWEH THROUGH YAHSHUA.**

Paul said, in times past, you were Gentiles.

**...who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands.**

What does that mean? What he's telling these lost tribes of Israel who were misidentified as Gentiles in the past is that your brother Judah, your sister Judah, did not recognize you. They called you uncircumcised. But now you have been brought back into covenant. Read.

**12 That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world.**

You were without what? *Yahweh*. Without Yahweh in the world. You were scattered. You were Jezreel. You were scattered and sowed. Let's read Romans 9:25-26. Here Paul is going to quote the very verse we are now reading in Hosea. He knew who these people were. Sadly the church doesn't know who they were, but Paul knew. Paul was not called to the Gentiles. Paul was called to the lost tribes who were identifying as Gentiles. Because the promise that Yahweh just made in the book of Hosea is only to who? Gomer! Israel! Ghomri!

### **Romans 9:25-26**

**25 As he says also in Osee (Hosea)...**

Who is Osee? Hosea. Where are we studying today, the book of what? *Hosea*. Here Paul is going to tell every one of you who these so-called Gentiles are. Don't let anybody ever think or convince you that Paul was called to the Gentiles. He is writing right now who he was called to.

**...I will call them my people, who were not my people, and her beloved, who was not beloved.**

The Christians think that's saying the Gentiles were not his people. Is anybody with me? That's what your church taught you that that verse meant, that that was to the Gentiles because they were never God's people. *Amen*. Brothers they lied to you. Paul was not called to the Gentiles! Neither was Yahshua! He said I only came to find that which I lost! *That's right. Oh hallelujah*. He only lost his wife!

Hosea lost his wife, Gomer. And you're going to find in the next chapter where Yahweh told Hosea...Now go find her! Yahshua is Hosea!! He was sent to find the lost wife. *The Ethnos*. Come on now. His kindred. Hallelujah. Now what is Paul referring to in Romans 9:25? He's referring to the verse we just read in Hosea 2:23 that says: I will sow her in the land. I will have compassion on her who did not have compassion. I will say to those who were not my people...**YOU ARE MY PEOPLE**. And they will say...You are now my (personal) God. No longer Baali, but Ishi. My individual God. My personal God. Paul quotes that scripture in Romans 9:25. *God overflowing with mercy*. Come on sister. Hallelujah. Read verse 26.

**26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people, there shall they be called the children of the living God.**

Oh hallelujah! Oh I thought he wasn't going to have mercy on them. I thought they were all going to hell. I thought if they didn't get in right now, they weren't ever going to get in. I thought that he was done with them. *Wow. Wow.* Brothers and sisters, if Yahweh loves his children half as much as I love mine, he could never inflict endless misery on them, ever. *Oh hallelujah, hallelujah.* If Yahshua is half as merciful as his brother Joseph was, he would never allow them to perish in the wilderness just because they sold him into slavery. Joseph had more mercy than we say Yahshua has, and Yahweh. Shame on the church for preaching such things.

See that's what I don't understand when people call us a cult. I don't understand because cult leaders sends everybody to hell who don't believe like them. They send everybody to hell that don't follow them. We do the total opposite. We set everybody free and let them know that joy comes in the morning even if you don't follow this ministry. *Amen pastor. Hallelujah. Thank you pastor.*

We're not like the Catholic Church. We don't have Dante's Inferno to throw you in! We don't make you pay your way out of hell here! We LOVE creation. We LOVE humanity. We pray for all men to be saved. *We're setting the captives free pastor!* Amen! Hallelujah. Glory! Glory! Glory! Brothers and sisters, how many of you could send your children into eternal torment? And yet the Father says that he loves us more than our own parents love us. He's got a plan.

Now the apostle Peter understood Hosea's prophecies. Let's read about it in 1 Peter 1:23-25.

**1 Peter 1:23-25**

**23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed...**

Now let's change that word born. *Begotten again.* Yes sir.

**...but of incorruptible, by the word of Yahweh, which lives and abides for ever.**

So you have not been begotten by the natural seed of your father. Listen. I need everybody to pay attention. When your mother and father copulated there was a seed. That seed produced sister so and so, a woman who acts like the seed that she came from. Human seed. When my mother and father copulated they

produced a little Vaughn. I came from a Vaughn seed. In that seed is the enemy of Yahweh because in that seed is rebellion. In that seed is the rebellion of my own father. And that rebellion goes from seed to seed all the way through. It creates a little brother so and so. And that brother will struggle with that hereditary seed all the days of his life. That is the seed you were begotten by the first time.

However, I love what Paul says. He's now speaking to a new group of people who have been "seeded" again. They have been begotten again. Not born again. Nobody in this room is born again. Oh God no. You better thank God you're not. Oh no, everyone in this room has been "seeded" again. If you don't know what I mean by you've not been born again, go read the book. It's on my website. Nobody is born again and the church lies to you every Sunday and convinces you you've been born again. That is the lie that keeps you defeated.

You've been begotten again, and you've been seeded again. When were you seeded? By the word of God and your baptism. When you heard the word. The word of God is the seed. It comes into your spirit-mind. And then that seed begins creating a new creature, a new person. That person the Bible said will die, your flesh. All flesh is like grass.

**24 For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower thereof falls away,**

**25 But the word of Yahweh endures for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.**

I love what Peter said in verse 25. But the seed word of the Lord abides forever. Did you hear me? THE SEED WORD ABIDES FOREVER. There are two kinds of seed. Seed that begets flesh, and then there's the seed that begets immortal, eternal life. And this is what 1 Peter 2:9-10 is referring to. Let's read it.

**1 Peter 2:9-10**

**9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people, that ye should show forth the praises of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.**

Who's he talking to there? I grew up in church believing that verse of scripture applied to all Christians—that we were all a royal priesthood, a holy nation. But let me show you who he's talking to. There's only one group of people that that verse applies to. I'll be a monkey's uncle if it's not going back to the book of Hosea. Read verse 10.

**10 Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of Yahweh, which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.**

What did Hosea prophecy about Gomer? What did he say would happen to Gomer only? She would be without mercy. No mercy. Loruhamah...there'll be no mercy, no compassion. But now we're going to take the Lo off of Ruhamah. And now you who were without mercy—only the lost tribes of the house of Israel. Welcome to Israel 101! You're learning who Israel is!

That scripture does not apply to anyone but the lost tribes. *We are inclining our ear unto instruction.* Amen elder. Brothers and sisters, here's what Peter just said to the lost tribes. He said to them: Before you came to Christ you had a natural seed line of Israel. A dead seed. A seed that will not give you eternal life. You were Loammi, not my people. But now that you've come to Christ you have received the remnant seed of Israel that you must have to be in the first resurrection. You had not received mercy. You were Loruhamah.

But now you have received it in Christ. And this is how Hosea's prophecy in Hosea 2 was fulfilled. Hosea prophesied without explaining how this was going to happen. Peter explained it. Hosea had no revelation about the two seeds, nor did he live to see it. Let's read 1 Peter 1:1-2. I want to show you the exact people who Peter was writing to, the only people he was writing.

### **1 Peter 1:1-2**

**1 Peter, an apostle of Yahshua Messiah, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,**

He's writing to Gentile cities: Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, Bithynia. Those are Gentile cities. That's why the church thinks he's writing to the Gentiles. But he tells you who he's writing to *in* those cities. And who is he writing to in that first verse? *Jezreel the scattered seed.* That's what he said, I'm writing to Jezreel. I'm writing to the scattered strangers who are trapped in those Gentile cities who think they're Gentiles. But he said I'm about to awaken the seed in you because I'm about to tell you who you are. Read 2.

### **2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of Yahweh the Father...**

You are not Gentile. You are elect. You are chosen in the foreknowledge of God. Wherever you've been scattered who were not my people. Hosea's prophecy is going to come to pass just the way Hosea prophesied it. Let's read Romans 9:6 now. It gets interesting here. Without the spiritual seed, without being begotten again, being a member of the lost tribes will do you no good. You're not



even an Israelite in the eyes of Yahweh just because you've got the natural seed of Israel.

### **Romans 9:6**

**Not as though the word of Yahweh has taken none effect. For they are not all Israel, which are of Israel.**

Oh my my my my my my! They are not Israel just because they are Israel! *Oh I'm a member of the lost tribes. I want to know what my genealogy is.* Great. It won't do you any good. *Oh I wonder if I'm from the tribe of...* You better be from the tribe of Yahshua is what you better be from. *Oh yeah. I wonder which one is my tribe.* Not all of Israel is Israel. Did you hear what Paul just said? Paul said, if you're still without Christ, you've got the dead seed of your father Israel, and it'll do you no good. You must come through the cross of Yahshua to be Israel!!!

That's why he said in the book of Revelation that the synagogue of Satan are those who claim to be Jews but they're not. He's talking about those who claim to be in the overcoming church, but they're not overcoming. *Oh I want to go visit the holy people in Jerusalem. I want to go see the holy nation.* Darling there is no such thing as a holy nation of sinners! Are you all hearing me? *Hallelujah. Amen pastor. That was a mouthful right there.*

*I want to go to the holy land.* You can't go to a holy land of sinners! The holy land is at 235 Old Spanish Trail, Waveland Mississippi! *If I could just get to Jerusalem.* You were there last night! There's gay pride parades right down town Jerusalem. Did you know that? There ain't no holy land. It's a historical land, absolutely. But there's a New Jerusalem that's being built right in front of you! It's being built right in front of of you! Everybody wants to go pray at the Wailing Wall when God cursed that temple!! *Oooh hallelujah.*

The glory left it! And went to the third temple! Just stay right where you are and wail baby! You're part of a Sarah, not Hagar! *Oooh hallelujah.* God's building something right in front of you that you don't even see just like they didn't see John the Baptist because they were too busy looking for something else. You don't see Jerusalem because you're busy looking at old Jerusalem. You're stuck with Hagar's mindset. You don't even understand what you're a part of!!!

They're not all Israel that descended from Israel. Oh darling those 12 gates to the city, the tribes of Israel? Oh no. That's not for the natural seed line. That's for the spiritual Israel that comes from the natural seed line. I hope you understood what I just said. He's only calling the natural seed line, but he's rejecting any of those seeds that don't get that spirit-seed in them. *You've got to have the vision pastor.* Amen.

*Well brother Vaughn, I don't understand. I'm going to help you understand. Romans 11:4-5. I'm going to show you what's happening in this our day.*

#### **Romans 11:4-5**

**4 But what saith the answer of Yahweh unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal.**

**5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.**

What did Paul just teach us? In the days of Elijah, all of Israel, the natural seed line. It was all Israel. It was Israelites worshipping Baal. The natural seed was worshipping Christmas trees, paganism. Elijah stood up. And Yahweh said to him, Elijah, no no no, you're not by yourself. I have reserved, out of all of the natural seed of Israel, a remnant who will not bow down to Baal. I'm only recognizing that remnant. Is anybody hearing me today?

Every one of you in here are the natural descendants of the lost tribes of Israel. But Yahweh doesn't recognize a one of you unless he reserved you in the remnant to not bow down to Baal !!! *Well brother Vaughn, is Israel bowing down to Baal today?* Yes. It's called Judaism. That is Baal. It's false religion. It is a false God. They have rejected the Messiah. They're a false religion. Some of you are so in love with Judaism. You might as well go to Catholicism!! It's all false !!!

*Teach pastor, hallelujah.* Somebody said you all are trying to be Jews. We're not trying to be anything like the Jews. We're trying to be the Remnant. *I rip my toilet paper on the Sabbath pastor.* Ha ha ha! Amen. Don't you love what he said? Read verse 5 again. That is so good.

**5 Even so then at this present time...**

Somebody say "at this present time". *At this present time.* Amen. Read...

**...there is a remnant according to the election of grace.**

According to the what? According to their birth? According to the fact they're natural Israelites? No no no no no no. Remember brothers and sisters, not all of Israel is coming. Only the remnant will return. *Amen. He would have mercy on who he would have mercy on.* If you don't believe me—there's your entire family. If you're descended from the lost tribes, guess who else is? Your whole families. Why haven't they returned? It's according to the election of God's grace. He chooses. Not you.

Now let's read more. Romans 11:7-8. Let's read more about this.

### **Romans 11:7-8**

**7 What then? Israel has not obtained that which he seeks for...**

Israel, the lost tribes, has not obtained what it was seeking for.

**...but the election has obtained it and the rest were blinded.**

And the rest of who? Not the Gentiles. The rest of Israel. There's your answer! *Why doesn't my family see it?! Aren't we all Israelites?* Yes, but only a remnant of Israel. And the rest...

**8 (According as it is written, Yahweh has given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear) unto this day.**

But the elect of Israel. Did you hear that? Israel doesn't find it. The lost tribes don't find this. Only the elect of. But notice they are the elect OF Israel. But not all of Israel. And the rest were? *Blinded*. Yes. So how do we get our families to be unblinded? You're Israel. You can pray for Yahweh to remove the blindness. You can petition for Yahweh—every time you pray for them, *Father would you for my sake remove the blindness? I pray. I petition you, remove the blindness.*

You don't remove the blindness. You'll make enemies out of them. Oh don't you go tell them they're wrong. No, no, no. Live your life. Live this truth and pray everyday for the blindness to fall from their eyes. Hallelujah.

Can I show you all when all of their eyes will be opened? It's called the second Passover. Many of you don't know about the second Passover. I'd like to teach it to you real quick in the book of Numbers 9:5-11. I'm going to show you something in Torah that very few teachers have ever taught. They've missed something very important here. Read all those verses and then I'm going to show you and help you understand what you just read.

### **Numbers 9:5-11**

**5 And they kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the first month at even in the wilderness of Sinai according to all that Yahweh commanded Moses, so did the children of Israel.**

**6 And there were certain men, who were defiled by the dead body of a man, that they could not keep the passover on that day...**

Listen. Listen. Passover has to be on the 14th day of the 1st month. But there were some people who were too messed up to accept Passover the first time. Oh! There was a group of people who were not able to accept Christ. They were not able to partake of Passover the first time. I want to show you the love of your heavenly Father. He said any man who doesn't keep Passover is cut off from Israel. That's the law. I want to show you where mercy always overrides the law!

**...and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day,**

**7 And those men said unto him, We are defiled by the dead body of a man, wherefore are we kept back, that we may not offer an offering of Yahweh in his appointed season among the children of Israel?**

*Moses! Moses! We missed it! We missed the altar call that the preachers gave while we were alive Moses (which is Yahshua by the way). We missed it!! Our minds weren't right. We were defiled Moses. We missed the Passover. We missed the sacrifice for our sins. We didn't accept it. We did not partake of it when we were supposed to. Read...*

**8 And Moses said unto them...**

Here's what Yahshua said...

**...Stand still...**

Stand still. We've got a plan for you son.

**...and I will hear what Yahweh will command concerning you.**

Oh let's see if Yahshua has a backup plan for everybody who missed it the first time. Oh!

**9 And Yahweh spake unto Moses, saying,**

And Yahweh said unto Yahshua, his prophet...

**10 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying...**

Speak! And say...

**...If any man of you or of your posterity shall be unclean by reason of a dead body, or be in a journey afar off...**

If you were just on a journey afar off. You were so far gone that you couldn't even hear the preaching, your minds were so messed up you were on a far journey—drugs and alcohol and everything had brought you on a far journey to where you could not take this Passover. Listen to what your heavenly Father said...

**...yet he shall keep the passover unto Yahweh.**

I'm going to give you a second chance. The 4th month, the 14th day of the 2nd month. If you missed it the first time I'm going to give you another Passover the 2nd month. Did anybody hear what I just preached there?! *Oh hallelujah*

*But they missed it! They broke the law. They did not accept the blood sacrifice then during the day of salvation. They missed it God! Now God you made all us—we had to be there. Now you need to send them to hell. They missed it.*

Moses said, let's see what Yahweh has to say about this. Ha, ha! He said, Yahweh we have some people, they were so far gone they couldn't accept Christ. And Yahweh said let's give them a second chance. Oh hallelujah! Let's give them a second Passover. Hallelujah. Oh his mercy overrides his judgment!!

We're going to end it there today. Hallelujah. Thank you Father for your marvelous truth. For your marvelous truth! Moses said let's see what Yahweh has to say about this. Ha, ha. If it were up to Moses, what was he about to tell them? *Sorry guys ya'll missed it. It's got to be the 14th day of the 1st month. Keep reading the rest.*

**11 The fourteenth day of the second month at evening they shall keep it, and eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.**

Brothers and sisters, they missed the Passover. But the Passover didn't miss them. *Oh thank you Father!* Hallelujah. Yahweh would have all men to come. Hallelujah. And he's got a plan. It's called the last great day of the feast when everyone will bow and call him Lord!

There will be another Passover!

Hallelujah. Oh hallelujah! Amen. God bless you for joining me today. Thank you for your time. I pray now that you can understand the word even better, and understand your Father's plan. We love you all and I'll see you all next Sabbath.
