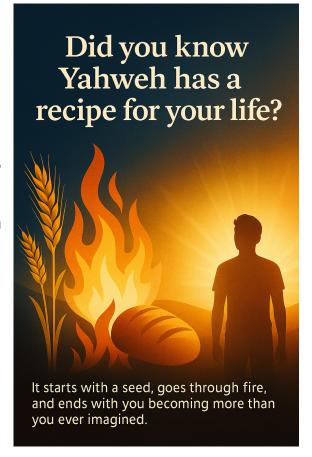


WELCOME TO SABBATH SCHOOL

Bring two loaves of bread to Yahweh... baked with leaven. These are a gift for Him.



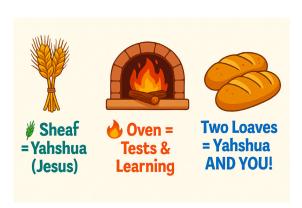
Yahweh isn't just teaching us about bread.
He's forming a loaf out of your life. A life that is ready to be used in His Coming Kingdom.

YOU'RE NOT JUST LEARNING SOMETHING — YOU'RE BECOMING SOMEONE.



A sheaf is the beginning. It's a bundle of grain, still rough, not yet ready. Yahshua was that first sheaf—set apart, waved before Yahweh.

But Yahweh said to count 49 days.
Why? Because those are the days when YOU are being made ready.
Just like wheat must be crushed, sifted, mixed with oil, and baked in fire—so must you.



On the 50th day, Yahweh didn't ask for another sheaf. He asked for two loaves.
And those loaves? That's Yahshua... and YOU.



Leaven is the thing that causes bread to rise. In the Bible, it can mean different things—sometimes bad (like pride or sin), and sometimes powerfully good (like the Holy Spirit).

At Passover, we get rid of old leaven. But at Pentecost? We bring new leaven. The right kind.
