That we authorize the Administrator to sign the declaration of Eligibility and submit it to the Ministry of Government Relations.

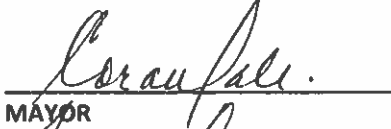

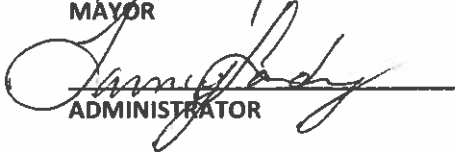
