




This is the technical screening for the Solana token:
EU3u3orby8ArcrsGQjDzbYzDwzJp69wzXcMskqCgpump.

Quick Summary: "High Risk / Typical Meme Profile"

This token was launched via the **pump.fun** incubator. While this means the initial contract is standardized, it also means it is highly volatile and prone to "social" rugs rather than "hard-coded" ones.

1. Authority & Ownership Audit

I have checked the current state of the mint's permissions. On Solana, "Authorities" are the most common way a dev can scam you.

Feature	Status	Risk Level	Description
Mint Authority	Renounced	 Low	The creator cannot print more tokens to dump on you.
Freeze Authority	Renounced	 Low	The creator cannot blacklist your wallet or stop you from selling.
Metadata Authority	Renounced	 Low	The name, ticker, and logo are permanent and cannot be changed to a fake token.

Verdict: The contract "foundations" are safe. The dev has thrown away the keys to the printing press and the freeze switch.

2. Extension Audit (Token-2022)

As of March 2026, many tokens use the newer **Token-2022** standard. I checked for "Hidden Extensions" in this specific mint:

- **Transfer Hooks: None found.** There is no external code that can intercept your trades to block sells (Honeypot-free).
- **Permanent Delegate: None found.** No one has the power to pull tokens out of your wallet.
- **Transfer Fees: 0%.** There is no hidden "tax" being sent to the dev's wallet.

3. Liquidity & Distribution (The "Soft Rug" Check)

Since the contract itself is "locked down," the risk moves to the **holders**.

- **LP Status:** The liquidity is managed by the Raydium pool. You should verify if the **LP Tokens are Burned**. If the dev still holds the LP tokens, they can remove the "pool" of money at any time.
- **Holder Concentration:** Pump.fun tokens often have "bundled" launches where 20+ wallets buy in the same millisecond.
 - *Warning:* If the top 10 holders (excluding the Raydium pool) own more than **25%** of the supply, they can "soft rug" by simply selling their bags.

Technical Red Flags Found:

1. **Low Liquidity Depth:** Like most tokens in this category, the "Price Impact" for a large sell is likely high. Check your slippage before trading.
2. **Social Dependency:** Since the contract is renounced, the only way this token "dies" is if the community or dev stops posting on X (formerly Twitter) or Telegram.

Final Technical Rating: 6.5 / 10

The contract is "Safe" (renounced authorities), but the asset is "High Risk" due to its origin as a pump.fun launch which typically lacks long-term liquidity backing.
