We hope everyone is doing well and staying healthy. We are excited to share some good news amidst the regular challenges we are all facing on the daily. Thanks to all of you for taking the time to pray for us and for partnering with us in making an impact here with the Deaf community of Ensenada. We are still declaring this year a year of JOY in service and ministry. Here are the latest updates:

#### CASA JOSUÉ

The Deaf men living there are slowly adjusting to the new program we have set out for them. Pray for our housing director, Carlos Suarez, to find wisdom and strength to continue to lead and encourage the men to keep striving to be like Jesus. Miguel David, who had left the program to be with his family in Sonora last year, has returned back into the program. After a yearlong pandemic break from university, Miguel David, Edgardo, and Carlos will return back **into their majors** to be future licensed teachers for the Deaf.





Furthermore, last month, we had a meeting with one of our board members, Erin Thompson, to discuss the future basic budgeting & finances workshop we will be offering for the Deaf men at Casa Josué. Erin provided all the material needed to begin teaching budgeting 101. Our goal with this is to give access to this type of information to the Deaf community in their native language, Mexican

Sign Language, so that they have the option of planning financially for their future.

## CASA MARAVILLAS



Good news! We just signed the lease for a temporary house for Casa Maravillas. The house is located about five minutes away from the Deaf association and from Frances' apartment in a relatively safe neighborhood. The great thing about the house is that it is fully furnished with three bedrooms, a bathroom, kitchen and living room. It

also has a decent backyard with several fruit and citrus trees. We are extremely grateful that it is only \$450 USD a month. We hope to continue to raise support to keep the house running for the year we will be there. Frances has been very busy in prepping the house so that the women moving in will have an easier transition. Pray that God will begin to lead Deaf women to our

ministry who need a safe place to grow in every aspect of their lives as they seek to become more independent.

Meanwhile, we are still praying and hoping for a miracle in order to purchase a plot of land we found down the street from Casa Josué. It looks like the total cost will range between \$30,000 - \$35,000 USD. We ask that you join us in prayer because we believe that God is a BIG, BIG God, and this is not impossible for Him.



We recently had the honor of moderating an event hosted by a local coffee shop called *Otro Café*, where Daniel López, president of the local Deaf association gave a talk on Deaf awareness. We are extremely grateful to *Otro Café* for creating an open space where the Deaf can come and raise their voices on different issues facing their community today.

One of our goals as a ministry is to provide job opportunities or workshops where the Deaf can receive training in different areas of work in order for them to have more employment opportunities with livable wages. Which is why on International Coffee Day (October 1<sup>st</sup>), we will be organizing alongside *Otro Café* our first basic coffee brew workshop with Deaf only attendees. We are excited to see how our relationship with this coffee shop continues to grow into greater things that will impact positively the Deaf community of Ensenada.
