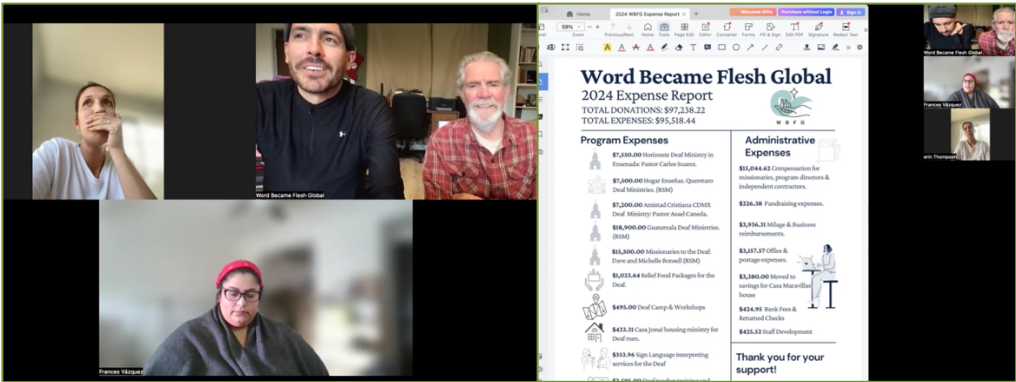

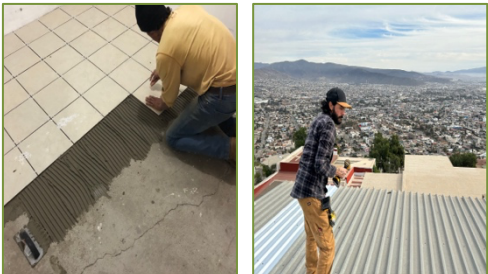

A Safe Space for German and his children

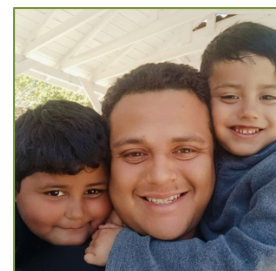
Earlier this year, **Germán**, a **single Deaf father**, was going through a heartbreaking situation. Due to unsafe conditions in his home, Germán had no choice but to temporarily place his two children in an orphanage until improvements could be made. His deepest desire was to bring them back, but he needed help. By God's grace, we were able to **come alongside Germán** and help build a **safe stairway to the second floor** of his home. This addition created a **private, secure space** where Germán and his children can now live together in dignity and peace.

Helping a Single Deaf Mother in Crisis

At the end of April, we had the **privilege of being a beacon of hope, mercy, and compassion** to Marisol, a Deaf single mother of two young children who was walking through an incredibly difficult season. Her situation was urgent—emotionally, spiritually, and practically.

We brought her out to Ensenada to spend a few days in prayer and counsel with Frances and Lucas. During her stay, **Amanda**, a local Deaf missionary, also stepped in to minister directly to Marisol's heart in her own language. It was a powerful time of healing and encouragement.

Marisol left with **renewed strength and a heart stirred with hope**, ready to face the challenges ahead with faith. Please continue to pray for her and her children.

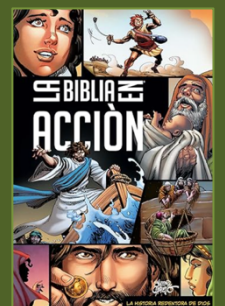
