In October, Leonardo found a stable job with benefits, and is continuing the GED program alongside our newest member to the program, **Alejandro, who moved here from Sinaloa. He supports himself by doing food delivery on his motorbike.**



The men's home is finally undergoing a slow process of being remodeled, **thanks to Joshua Everett and to our givers who are making this possible.** Besides helping us install a new boiler and pantry, Joshua and Sammy Everett were able to replace and fix the rotted wooden stairs going up to the second floor of our ministry.
