
CASA JOSUÉ

We have a new bathroom! This might seem mundane, but it is a huge step for us in improving the Deaf men's housing ministry. Once we started the demolition of the old bathroom, we realized it was going to be a bigger project than expected. As soon as we removed the tile floor, we noticed that there was black mold everywhere! We completely removed the rotted floor and eliminated the mold as fast as we could. After 10 days' worth of work, we were able to completely restore the bathroom thanks



to the hard work of Joshua and Samuel Everett, and to givers like you who made this possible. In the next month, we hope to begin fixing the second bathroom.

At the moment, Casa Josué has five Deaf men in the program: Alejandro, Leonardo, Jose Antonio, Noel, and

We believe God is big and can do anything when we step out into faith, so we are praying for the perfect place to establish the permanent home of Casa Maravillas.

Karen recently left for a couple of months to visit her family in Oregon. Since her college studies have been put on hold due to the pandemic, she decided it was the right time to leave and spend time with her family. We ask that you keep Celeste in your prayers as we are still unable to make contact with her mother to find out how they are doing. We also want to thank everyone who sent clothes, toys, and supplies down for Celeste's family. We are hoping to eventually travel down south and deliver them in person.

One of our core values as WBFG is "Honoring Partnerships: We look to come alongside existing Deaf organizations by connecting them to resources in order to help meet their objectives." Our passion is seeing other Deaf organizations in our area succeed in their own mission and objectives. Because of the pandemic, the local Deaf association took a big financial hit. One of the reasons was that the enrollment into their sign language program dropped significantly. On top of that, the Deaf teachers in the program also found out that their temporary teaching credentials had expired and they would have to pay a hefty fee to retake the test within the Department of Education in order to be certified again. Thanks to our generous givers, we were able to provide the finances for at least four of their teachers to get recertified in teaching. We hope to further strengthen our bond with the local Deaf association so that we are able to have a broader impact on the Deaf community in Ensenada.

We recently had our first board meeting of the year with the executive board members to not only discuss the future but also recount everything that God has done in 2020 through our ministry. We were blown away! God is still moving, and we just have to choose if he is going to move through us or through another vessel. We pray that every day this year we wake up and say "yes!" to allow ourselves to be conduits of the Spirit of God for people who are hungry and dying for a touch of His presence. Amen!
