We are deeply grateful for the support and prayers from all our donors who have kept us continuing with our mission of manifesting the love of Jesus and serving the Deaf of Ensenada. We have many updates of how God has used us to bless people in need. Here are the latest ministry developments:

## Casa Josué

We have two new Deaf men living in the men's ministry home: Severo and Carlos!

We knew Severo already because he used to be a student from RSM school for the Deaf. Severo had a desire to continue his high school studies and we offered him a spot in the program to be able to help him achieve his educational goals, and at the same time, help him grow into an independent spiritually-mature Deaf man.

Carlos' story is a bit different. Our house leader, Edgardo, met Carlos out on the street and started a conversation with him. Edgardo later found out that he was living on the streets and looking for a job. After some

## Casa Maravillas

In September, we decided to discontinue our lease for the women's Deaf home due to various factors. It was a blessing to the Deaf women that passed through the program in their time of need, but the rent started to become very expensive.

We decided to now focus on building up the finances to actually purchase a plot of land where we can have a permanent place to invest in.

This does not mean our ministry to Deaf women has stopped. Frances has continued her ministry to women in the Deaf community by maintaining contact with them, inviting them to coffee, interpreting for them at doctor's appointment, and encouraging them at church.

Every week, Frances and another Deaf missionary friend (Amanda) has been working close with a Deaf women named Rocio.

Rocio suffered a stroke last year and is in a really bad place physically because of it. Frances & Amanda have been busy taking her to physical therapy and interpreting for her there. Besides that, they have made regular visits to her home where they spend time with her by encouraging her and sometimes even playing games with her so that she regains better motor skills she had lost during the stroke. Pray for healing!

Most Deaf individuals live of low wages in Mexico and buying new shoes would cost about 2-3 days' worth of wages.
