Commissioned by South Lanarkshire Council to create a life-size mosaic lion sculpture, for the public art sculpture trail 'The Big Stampede'. Which was held in Hamilton Scotland. The sculpture raised over £6,600 for Glasgow Children's Hospital charity, when sold as the top selling artwork in a charity auction. The design of the sculpture is based upon the ancient woodland found in the Clyde Valley, South Lanarkshire. Such as the woodlands found at New Lanark.
