GP Scientific introduces recyclable and biodegradable packing materials



At GP Scientific we try to do our bit towards reducing our environmental impact. With increasing concern about plastic contamination, we are working to remove all plastic from our packaging. We're not quite there yet, but we are pleased to announce that we have made changes to minimise the plastic we use, and to increase the amount of biodegradable, and recyclable materials.

So, from now:

- Our boxes are now 75% minimum recycled cardboard and completely recyclable.
- Our box sealing tape is now paper 0% plastic and fully recyclable with the boxes.
- Our bubble-wrap is now recyclable and biodegradable.
- Our clear tape is now natural cellulose 0% plastic and fully biodegradable.
- Our shipping documentation is PEFC and EU Ecolabel certified paper and is fully recyclable.

You won't notice much difference when you receive shipments, and our shipments will still be packed in the same safe, secure way, but you can now be confident that these packing materials can be safely recycled using your normal local recycling facilities.

The individual packing of the purifier tubes still uses plastic, however we have carefully chosen materials that have the lowest environmental impact. All the tube packing is recyclable and is free from heavy metals, or other toxic chemicals.

Unfortunately, the legally required Dangerous Goods label, and the courier's transparent pouch containing the shipping documents are still made from plastic and are not yet recyclable.

We are working on ways to eliminate the remaining plastic items from our packaging and we will introduce recyclable and biodegradable alternatives as soon as they are available.
