Measures to Prevent Age Fraud:

- 1.Entry and Registration: All entries for age categories must be submitted online by district associations at least 7 days before the championship begins. Player registration is also conducted online. Verification of players involves checking a bonafide certificate, Aadhaar card, and passport copy—documents officially certified by the government. If any concerns or objections arise regarding a player after these documents have been verified, medical tests will be carried out for players in the Under 11 and Under 14 categories during the National Championship. These tests will be conducted by qualified professionals.
- 2. Procedures for Handling Age Fraud: Should a team suspect that a player is overage, they may file a formal protest. This protest must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the game. The Technical Committee for that tournament will review the protest and impose appropriate sanctions. The possible sanctions are as follows:
- 3.i) The player in question will be prohibited from participating further in the current tournament.
- 4.ii) The player will be barred from competing in any subsequent tournaments within the same calendar year.
- 5.iii) If the current tournament is the last event of the calendar year, the player will be banned from participating in any tournaments for the following calendar year.
- 6.iv) In cases where a player is found overage during the league stages, the outcome of the last match played by the team may be adjusted if necessary. If the opposing team lost that game, they will be declared the winner. However, the affected team may continue in the tournament, excluding the player found to be overage. This rule applies to teams with no more than two overage players in a match.
- 7.v) A team found fielding three or more overage players in a match will face disqualification from the tournament. The team will not be allowed to participate in any further matches of the tournament. Such an infraction may result in a ban of up to two years for the team from participating in any tournaments within that age group.
- 8.vi) Coaches of teams involved in age fraud will be suspended from participating in tournaments for up to two calendar years.
- 9.vii) For offenses involving players in the Under 11 and Under 14 categories, the District Association will incur a fine of Rs. 3000/-.
- 10. viii) For offenses involving players in the Under 17 category, the District Association will incur a fine of Rs. 5000/-.
