Thousands of Angelenos gathered at Gloria Molina Grand Park on July 4 for the City of L.A.'s annual Summer Block Party, transforming six blocks of Downtown Los Angeles into a vibrant celebration of music, culture, and community.

Recognized as the West Coast's largest free Fourth of July celebration, the event offered an evening of live entertainment, interactive experiences, and family-friendly activities for visitors of all ages.

The Backyard Stage featured an energetic lineup led by acclaimed trumpeter Tatiana Tate, whose blend of jazz, funk, soul, and hip-hop captivated the crowd. Jungle Fire & Friends kept the celebration moving with their signature mix of Afro-Caribbean rhythms, West African grooves, Latin influences, and classic funk, while Kaimera added dynamic dance performances. KCRW's Anthony Valadez hosted the Backyard Stage with live DJ sets, and Pangea Sound brought global beats from the Caribbean, Africa, and Latin America to the Front Yard Stage.

Sampa Elevates Filipino Cuisine

Sometimes the best dining experiences are the ones you don't expect. Singer and entertainer GG Starr and I recently visited **Sampa** in Downtown Los Angeles' Arts District, where we enjoyed a memorable dining experience that redefined our expectations of Filipino cuisine. Created by Chef Josh Espinosa, Sampa reimagines Filipino flavors through modern techniques and creative presentation. We enjoyed the Filipino Ceviche, the Crispy Pasta topped with crispy pork, the restaurant's elevated take on *Kuhol*, and a delicate puffed SkyFlakes cracker topped with A5 wagyu, calamansi crème fraîche, and Kaluga caviar, beautifully served atop a SkyFlakes cracker box—a playful nod to a beloved Filipino pantry staple. We ended the meal with the light and airy Ube Bibingka Soufflé, a modern twist on classic Filipino favorites.

Every dish was thoughtfully prepared, beautifully presented, and perfectly portioned, leaving us completely satisfied without feeling overly full. Sampa is the kind of restaurant I'd confidently recommend to friends, family, business associates, or anyone experiencing Filipino cuisine for the first time. With its innovative menu, impeccable presentation, and warm hospitality, it delivers a dining experience that is truly a cut above the rest. We left already looking forward to our next visit.
