

A charlatan clairvoyant with a history of paranoid schizophrenia in the family experiences visions that try to tell her about the stabbing that left her agoraphobic, and an unholy pact her mother made with demonic entities known as the Unholy Trinity.

Synopsis

SARA (50) is a divorcee who has become agoraphobic after being mugged and stabbed. She lives now in a small flat, her only contact with the outside world her brother, ADAM (46), who brings her groceries and doles her medication out daily – a precaution after a suicide attempt.

Everything else is done through Zoom: communicating with her daughter, ANGEL (13); her psychiatric appointments; and her job as a (fake) psychic.

One night, Sara sees the bloodied apparition of her mother, CARMEN (69). Carmen, a paranoid schizophrenic, has been institutionalized since inexplicably stabbing Angel in the face during a birthday party. Adam calls then, telling Sara that Carmen has attempted suicide, but she's now sedated and fine.

This event marks a change in Sara's life.

She begins seeing other apparitions: among others, THE CRYING GIRL (9), who sits on the kitchen floor, reciting a nursery rhyme; THE WHISPERING WOMAN (34), who begs for help in a strangled whisper; and THE NO MAN (50), a behemoth who threatens Sara. Sara's terrified, but due to her agoraphobia can't leave her house.

Adam's dismissive, believing this is mental illness given their mother's history. He's also stressed because he's having family issues, dealing with his struggling business, and because Sara hasn't signed insurance forms he's brought around.

Sara's sure something's happening and watches the psychiatric interviews that were conducted with Carmen. Carmen claimed to be a medium who contacted a trio of demonic entities, the Unholy Trinity. The Trinity sought to use her as a vessel but found her flawed. They then focused on Angel. This is why Carmen stabbed her – to stop them.

When Sara's main client, JOSHUA (40) – a paranoid man, who suspects his partner is cheating – reports she took her own life, Sara suspects Joshua is responsible and cuts off contact.

But Joshua comes around and during their exchange, Sara reconciles The Whispering Woman is Joshua's partner. Joshua reveals he was once in an institution, and Carmen gave him readings in exchange for stabbing Sara – this was Carmen's attempt to stop the Unholy Trinity inhabiting her.

Joshua attacks; Sara fights him off – Adam arrives and helps incapacitate Joshua.

After police take Joshua away, Adam criticizes Sara for believing she's psychic like their mother. He says she's sick and this is why Sara's ex won't let the kids come over.

Sara is devastated. Once Adam leaves, she takes an overdose of meds she's stockpiled, but nothing happens.


Adam's been giving her placebos.

Sara calls his home, but his wife reports he's gone – they split up months ago. Sara checks the insurance forms and finds they're a Power of Attorney, transferring control of Carmen's finances solely to Adam.

Adam comes over with Angel. He admits he's been manipulating Sara – his business is struggling and he needs the money – and that Carmen did take her life the night Sara saw the apparition.

Sara and Adam fight, but Angel intercedes to save her mother.

But The No Man is also present and demands a reckoning.





Visual References






The key to horror is location. These stories here are intrinsically about the concentration of a haunting centering around characters in a specific location.

Heritage takes it further, though. One of the questions often asked in a horror is, "Why don't they just move?"

Sara can't. She's agoraphobic. So she's trapped in her own madness, a cold, bleak, and terrifying world that increasingly becomes her prison.

But is this really happening? Or is it all part of her deteriorating mental health?

The story tries to put the audience in Sara's world as it closes in around her.

Sara

About fifty, Sara's struggling with where she fits in the world. Although she survived a mugging, she's become agoraphobic, works as a fake online psychic, and is estranged from her 13-year-old daughter and her husband.

She never leaves the house, and relies exclusively on her brother, Adam, to bring her groceries and medication, and her psychiatrist, Dr. Beck, who she consults via Zoom.

When Sara begins having visions of the dead, she wonders if her charlatan powers have become authentic, or if she's developing schizophrenia, like her institutionalised mother.



Ana Isabel

Ana is a Melbourne-based actor, writer and producer who has studied extensively at various acting schools, including the prestigious Howard Fine Acting Studio.

She wrote, produced, and starred in the social satire webseries *OzLinked*, and wrote the original story for her comedy feature, *Hot Flush*, which is currently in postproduction.

Constantly in demand, she has appeared in various film, TV series, and TV commercials, as well as numerous theatre productions.

Cast and Characters

Adam

Adam is Sara's younger brother. He brings her groceries, medication, and oversees all her medical and legal needs.

Although he's conscientious, he holds no truck with her psychic con, and believes that her mental health concern, and their mother's, is a sign of weakness.

When he's not looking after Sara, Adam has his own wife and children, and runs a struggling business – his third. While maintaining an entrepreneurial spirit and always on the lookout for a good deal, he struggles with the financial realities of good management.



Scott Major

Scott has worked extensively in television, theatre and film around the world for the last 28 years.

Some of his regular television roles include *Heartbreak High*, *Wildside*, *Neighbours*, *Always Greener* and *Late for School*. Film credits include *Envy*, *He died with a Falafel in his hand*, *Ned* and *The Heartbreak Kid*.

He founded Bathroom Floor Productions in 2004 and his recent theatre work includes *All This Intimacy, Both Sides of the Bar, The Fellatio Monologues, Death in a box: one pussy's tale, The Subtle Art of Flirting, Closer, Terminus and Salt.*

Carmen

Sara and Adam's mother, Carmen's always been into spirituality, which then blossomed into a belief in the occult.

Later in life, she developed schizophrenia, and believed she was communicating with the "Unholy Trinity", a trio of spirits who were trying to use her as a vehicle into this world.

Believing Sara's daughter, Angel, was the latest vessel the Unholy Trinity was trying to occupy, Carmen tried to kill her, and was institutionalised.



Loraine Fabb

Loraine says she's always been an actress and a creative. She remembers she used to hop out of bed to act out bedtime stories when she was a little kid.

Her experience across the years between then and now covers film, television, theatre, commercial projects and education.

Loraine's recent work includes Nathan and Theodore Sadden's *Son of a Donkey* comedy series soon to screen on Netflix, and ABC TV's *Fires* series.

Cast and Characters

Angel

Sara's 13-year-old daughter, Angel exhibits typical teenage rebelliousness, but it's also fuelled by a belief that her mother hasn't protected her, and that her mother's agoraphobia means they can't have a genuine mother-daughter relationship. Angel's lost, and struggling to work out where she fits in the world, albeit without much success.



Diviya Mahto

Diviya (Div) has been passionate about acting since the age of five and has appeared in productions such as *Chicago* (Student Version), *We Will Rock You, Legally Blonde*, and *Peter Pan* as Tiger Lily. Her on-screen experience includes a role in the feature film *Hot Flush*.

Striving to develop her skills, Div has taken part in additional acting workshops with TAFTA Productions, TCA, and Premier.

Currently, she's in rehearsals for *Mamma Mia* while also expanding her creative talents by directing *The Laramie Project* – a powerful and challenging piece.

With every performance, she continues to grow as an artist, excited for what lies ahead in this dynamic and inspiring field.

Sara's best friend, Mystique got her into the fake psychic game. But whereas Sara is traumatised through her experiences, Mystique is bright, vivacious, and loves life. She's quirky and colourful, and tries to find a way to bring joy and hope to Sara's life.

Cast and Characters

Dr. Paul Beck

Beck provided the initial evaluation of Carmen, and is now Sara's psychiatrist.

Seemingly solid, reliable, and a constant moral check, Beck is more of a friend than a clinician.

But he has his own murky past, where he was discharged for unprofessionalism.



Greg Pandelidis

Greg has been acting in Australia on stage and in film and TV for over twenty years.

He is immensely passionate about offering audiences a more visceral experience, to feel moved and inspired by the stories he helps bring to life. He has worked on many top notch films, television shows and stage productions.

Career highlights have included working alongside Guy Pearce in *Jack Irish; My False Vacuum,* which won Best International Film at the Swedish Film Festival; and winning a scholarship studying in New York at the Atlantic Acting school.

Joshua

One of Sara's online clients, Joshua is in his thirties, and relies on Sara because he's insecure about his own relationship. He grows possessive and irrational, and increasingly reliant on Sara.

When his partner dies, the question becomes whether he was in any way responsible, and if he'll also become a danger to Sara.

Seth was born in Westchester, N.Y. He received a B.A. in Film & TV from Columbia College Chicago in 2011, and graduated from The Second City's Musical Improvisation Conservatory (Chicago) in 2015.

One of Sara's more frequent ghostly visitations, The Crying Girl is found in the kitchen, a bright light on her, reciting an old poem:

Now I lay me down to sleep,
I pray thee, Lord, my soul to keep
If I should die before I wake,
I pray the Lord my soul to take.


She is a manifestation of the innocence Sara has lost, but is also trying to communicate another message.

Loren Lennox


A natural performer from a young age, Loren has been singing and acting since she could walk.
