Matt's House Emergency Shelter offers a safe haven for homeless women and mothers with children who have nowhere else to turn. Each night, guests receive a secure place to sleep, an evening meal, and a light breakfast during the day.

Their mission is to provide compassionate, dignified emergency shelter while offering the essential support our guests need to move toward stability. In addition to meals and lodging, residents receive hygiene products, clothing, and referrals to housing and employment resources.

Children staying at Matt's House are enrolled in our After School Program and Summer Camp, ensuring they have structure, support, and a safe environment. Through individualized case management, each guest is connected with resources tailored to their unique needs, empowering them on their path to long-term independence.
