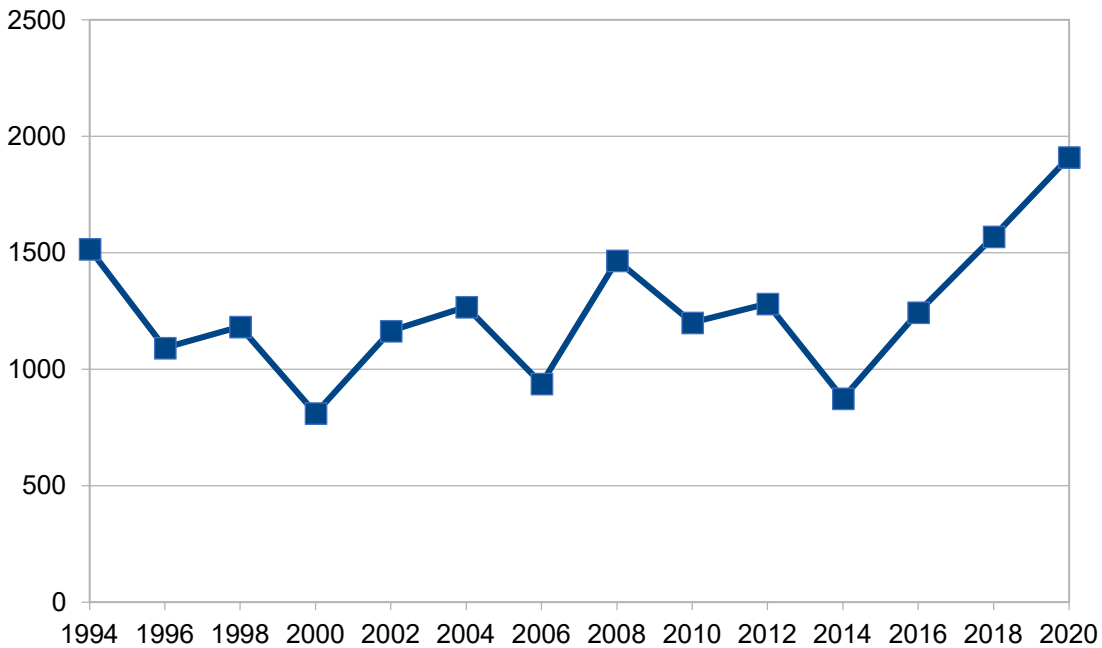

2020: 1,911

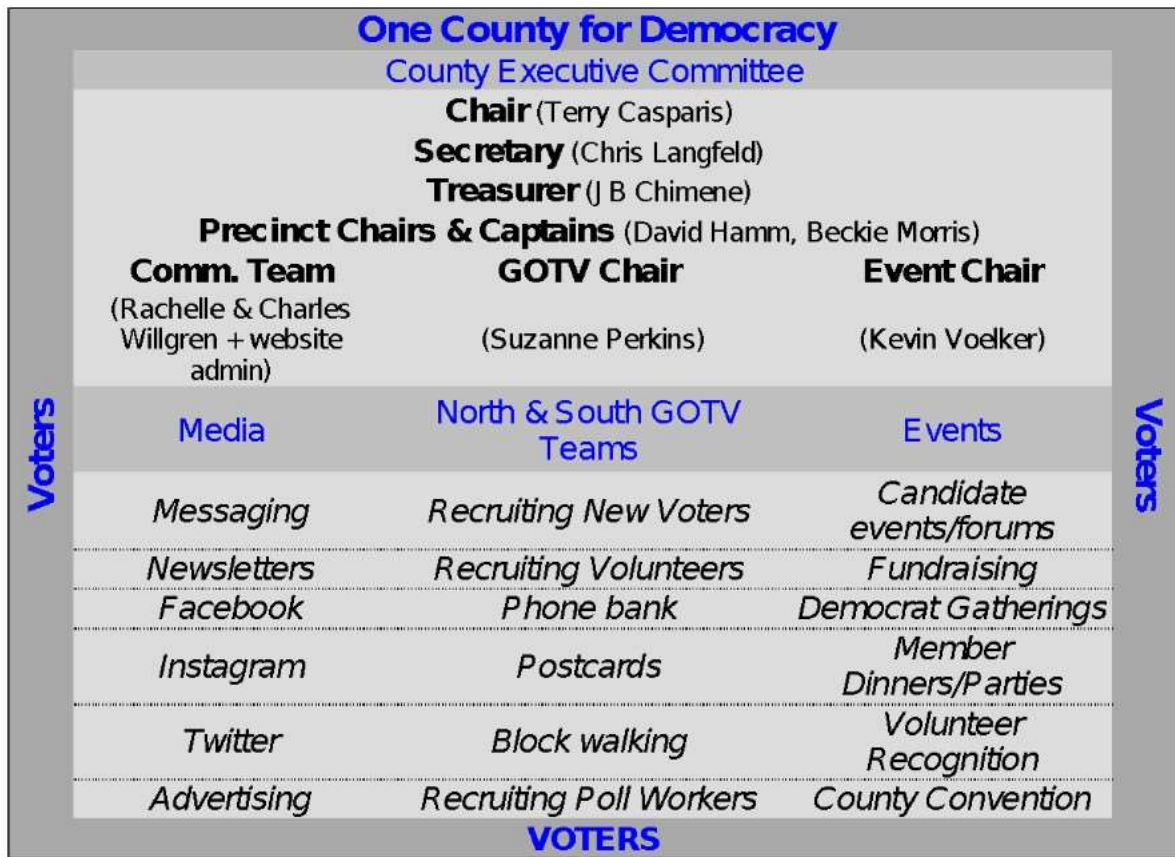
1992: 891
