Privacy Policy and Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

Welcome to the official website (the “website” or “site”) for Make Moderates Matter LLC (“we”, “us”, “our” or “MMM”). We understand that visitors to our website may have questions about how this website collects and uses information. We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our supporters’ information. This Privacy Policy and Terms and Conditions (“Policy”) explains our privacy practices and the terms under which you may access this website (“Website”). The Policy includes: the type of information we may collect from you when you use the Website; how we may use that information; with which third parties we share or disclose such information; and your preferences regarding our use and disclosure of such information.

This Policy only applies to the information collected by us and any third parties acting with our authorization. Currently the only such third-party is GoDaddy Operating Company, LLC and its affiliates (“GoDaddy”), which is the company we are using to host the Website. This Policy applies regardless of the computer, mobile phone, tablet, or other electronic device (“Device”) you use to access the Website.

By accessing the Website, you agree that your use of the Website is governed by this Policy. From time to time, we may update this Policy and we encourage you to periodically check this Policy for updates. Your continued use of the Website affirms your agreement to any changes we make to this Policy.

2. Information We Collect About You

Information You Choose to Provide to Us. We collect any information you provide to us on or through the Website or in any other way. For example, we collect your email address and any other information (such as your name) you may submit when you contact us by email with questions or comments.

User Submissions. Any information, communications, or material of any type or nature that you submit to our Website by email or otherwise (collectively, a “Submission”), is done at your own risk and without any expectation of privacy.

Usage Data and Technical Information. The Website includes features that automatically collect certain information, which may include the unique Device identifier assigned to your Device. The Website may use “cookies” (which are small data files containing information about you that is stored on your hard drive), “embedded scripts,” “pixel tags,” and other similar tracking technologies (collectively, “Tracking Technologies”) to collect information automatically as you interact with the Website. Such information may include behavioral data such as clicks and individual page visits and other relevant statistics. Tracking Technologies also collect aggregated, anonymized data to improve the website’s performance, such as page loading speed. Such information may be collected by us and/or by GoDaddy.

3. How We Use Information That We Collect

We will not sell your personal information to anyone. In addition, we will not share your personal information with any third parties except GoDaddy solely for purposes of providing, supporting and administering the Website.

Except as subject to Section 4, we may use information we collect for, among other things, the following purposes:

- Sending you updates and marketing e-mails regarding the Website;
- Notifying you about new features and information available through the Website;
- Responding to your questions, comments or other requests;
- Preventing and detecting fraud or infringement of our or any third party's rights;
- For other purposes disclosed at the time you provide us with information or which are reasonably necessary to provide the Website;
- Accumulating and reporting aggregate, statistical information in connection with the Website and user activity;
- Determining which features and services users like best to help us operate, enhance and improve the Website;
- Subject to applicable contractual or legal restrictions, in connection with a sale of all or substantially all of the assets of MMM.

4. Opting-Out of Certain Uses Of Your Information

Marketing and Promotional Communications. We currently do not plan to allow visitors to our website to proactively subscribe to receive email updates and marketing messages regarding the Services but will respond if you submit a question or comment to us via email. If you send us an email and receive a response from us, you may discontinue any further communications from us at any time by replying with "STOP" in the subject line of your email. Other privacy requests can be emailed to Doug@MakeModeratesMatter.com. Please note that "STOP" requests may not take effect immediately and may take a reasonable amount of time to receive, process, and apply.

If you contact us by email to submit information, questions or feedback to us, we may retain your emails and other information you submit to us for our internal purposes, and to help us serve you better.

Privacy Preferences. You may change certain privacy preferences (e.g., choose to cease receiving communications) by sending an email to us at Doug@MakeModeratesMatter.com detailing your privacy request. If you ask us to stop using your personal information, we will honor that request, provided that we may retain a record of such information as necessary to comply with applicable law and we may continue to use your contact information to respond to your requests.

Opting-Out of Use of Certain Information That May be Collected by Tracking Technologies.

- **Tracking Technologies:** Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies (other than Flash cookies) and allow local storage, but you should be able to change your settings to notify you when a cookie is being set or updated, local storage is being used, and/or to block cookies and/or the use of local storage altogether. Please consult the “Help” section of your browser for more information. Please note that by blocking any or all cookies you may not have access to certain features or content available through the Website.
- **Flash Cookies:** Users can manage the use of Flash technologies, with the Flash management tools available at Adobe’s website, see <https://www.macromedia.com/support/documentation/en/flashplayer/help/help09.html>.
- **Do-Not-Track Signals:** Certain browsers transmit “do-not-track” signals to the websites with which such browsers communicate; however, this feature, and how it is used and activated, varies from browser to browser. Therefore, it is not clear whether the signals are intentionally transmitted by a user, or whether a user is even aware of this. Despite current efforts, there is still disagreement amongst leading internet standards organizations, industry groups, technology companies and regulators, concerning what, if anything, websites should do when they receive such signals and no standard has been adopted to date. We take privacy and security very seriously. With respect to “do not track signals,” we currently do not take action in response to these signals, but if a standard is established and accepted, we may reassess how to respond to these signals.

5. Sharing and Disclosure of Information We Collect

Disclosure to Third Parties. We will not sell your personal information to anyone. In addition, we will not share your personal information with any third parties, except for GoDaddy, solely for purposes of providing, supporting and administering the Website.

Additional Disclosures. There may be instances when we may access or disclose information without providing you a choice in the following circumstances: (i) to protect or defend the legal rights or property of MMM; (ii) to protect the safety and security of our Website and users; (iii) to protect against fraud or for risk management purposes; (iv) if we believe your actions violate this Policy; or (v) to comply with law or legal processes.

6. Data Collection from Children

This website complies with the Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998. We do not knowingly contact or collect personal information from children under the age of 13 without appropriate parental notice and consent, and our Website is not intended to solicit information of any kind from children under the age of 13. If we are informed that we have unintentionally received personal information from a child under the age of 13, we will delete that information. 8. Your California Privacy Rights

9. Location and Usage of The Website

We are based in the United States and the Website is operated and administered within the United States. The Website is also directed to users who are United States residents and this Policy is intended for them.

10. Integration of Third-Party Platforms and Website

The Services may be linked to, rely on, and/or be integrated with other websites, applications, interfaces, services, and/or platforms operated by third-party companies ("Third-Party Platforms"). For example, GoDaddy provides our website. In addition, our website includes links to our videos on YouTube, and for informational purposes, includes links to magazine and newspaper articles and the websites for political parties and organizations. When you click these links, you will be directed to an external website. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of any Third-Party Platforms that are linked to, rely on, and/or are integrated with the Services. If you visit, access, interact with, and/or otherwise use the Website from a location outside the United States, please be advised that any information you provide in connection with any such activity may be processed in and/or transferred to the United States of America and/or other territories and locations, where privacy protections may not be as comprehensive as those in the territory or location where you interact with or otherwise use the Website. By using the Website, you affirmatively consent to the transfer, use, disclosure, provision, and other administration of your information as described herein.

14. Copyright Complaints

By using the Website, you agree that any action at law or in equity arising out of or relating to this Policy shall be filed only in the state and federal courts located in the State of Florida, and you hereby irrevocably and unconditionally consent and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts over any suit, action, or proceeding arising out of this Policy.

This document is the sole statement of the Website's Policy and no summary, restatement or other versions thereof, or other privacy statement or policy, in any form, including, without limitation, machine-generated, is valid.
