Welcome to the new school year at Write Start Learning Center! Going back to school for your child means meeting new friends, new teachers, and many new learning experiences and opportunities. We will provide tremendous opportunities for your children to build on self-help skills and develop early literacy skills. We ask that you please have your child here at school by 9:30 am. Please be aware if your child only attends the **3 hour program** and Pinellas county is closed then there will be no 3-hr VPK that day.

Please be sure to sign your child In/Out in their classroom binders with the time and your full signature daily. This is very important that this is being done daily by whomever drops or picks up. This includes full time and 3 hr. VPK students as well.

Here's a yummy recipe to make at home! Homemade oven chips!

Ingredients: 2 medium Yukon Gold or Idaho potatoes, peeled and sliced into 1/8-inch slices on a mandoline or other handheld slicer

3 tablespoons olive, canola, or peanut oil

Salt and pepper if you prefer

Preparation: Preheat the oven to 400°F. Slice the potatoes into a bowl and immediately toss them with the oil. Season lightly with salt and arrange them in a single layer on a baking sheet. Bake in the oven until golden brown — about 12-15 minutes. Season again lightly with salt and pepper when they come out of the oven. Transfer to a rack to cool for maximum crispness.
