- If your child is going to be absent, please let us know ASAP by calling, using brightwheel, or email. This is a Licensing rule and regulation.
- If any of your contact information has changed including people on your pick-up list, please make the necessary changes in the office with Nycole or Crystal.
- If you need to add a person on your child's pick up list you must include the following information.. Full name, Address, and telephone number of the authorized person.
- We ask that children are dropped off no later than 10:00am unless they are in VPK. (VPK starts at 9:30am). If they have an appointment, please contact Nycole.
- If your child attends the 3Hr. VPK program please remember to get here as close to 9:30am as possible and pick up no later than 12:30pm.
- Please make sure your child is picked up no later than 5:30 each day
- Please do not send your child to school sick
- Please leave all toys from home at home unless instructed otherwise from your child's teacher
- If there is a change to your child's diet, please notify the office ASAP so we can work together to make accommodations.
- Write Start Learning Center is a Smoke Free Facility. Please no smoking on the property this includes E-Cigarettes.
- Closed-toed shoes should be worn daily. Unless otherwise stated by your child's teacher.
- Please be sure you label all of your child's belongings.
- Write Start Learning Center is a Nut-Free facility.
- Write Start Learning Center is not permitted to use any creams brought in home that have expired.
- All food items that are donated for parties must be store bought.
- Please remember to be signing your child In/Out daily with your signature as it appears on your Driver's license or ID card.
- Please be courteous and cautious as you are driving through our parking lot.
- Please do not leave children unattended in a vehicle without an adult
- For the safety of all, please make sure your child is completely buckled before driving leaving our premises.
- Please check your child's folder daily for any artwork, or note reminders.
