

Hotshot T-Shirt Collection

The hotshot crew t-shirt display here at the Wildland Firefighter Foundation has its roots in a collection started by Rowdy Muir, a long-time wildland firefighter from Utah who eventually rose to the rank of Incident Commander for a National Type 1 IMT. During his career, Rowdy accumulated t-shirts from crews who worked with his team on fires. In 2003, he donated his collection to the Foundation. The collection has continued to grow and now includes nearly all the current crews and many crews no longer in service.
