Pear-Mint Salad with Parmesan Shavings

Why it's good for you? High antioxidants in greens and pears. Mint is antibacterial. Plus: vinegar suppresses blood sugar rises. Mint thwarts the growth of infectious bacteria.

Serves 2/Calories 140/ Fat 7.9g /Saturated Fat 2.4g/Protein 4.9g /Carbohydrate 15g/Sodium 185mg/Fiber 2.9g

- 1 pear (preferably red) quartered, cored & cut into thin lengthwise slices
- 1 ½ T balsamic vinegar
- 3 T shavings of Parmesan or Romano cheese
- 2 T chopped fresh mint
- 1 T chopped walnuts
- 2 T extra-virgin olive oil



Marinate pear slices in balsamic vinegar 5 minutes, tossing to coat. Drain pears, reserving vinegar. On two salad plates, place equal amounts of greens. Top with pears, cheese, mint, and nuts. Mix reserved vinegar with oil, drizzle over salad.
