- This event is a single vehicle event, you are racing a clock, not other vehicles.
- Must have helmets and working seat belts, eye protection is mandatory if the windshield is removed.
- Must be ages 12 & up to run in this event. Participants under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. All age groups will run together. No one under the age of 16 will be allowed to run in the SxS division
- If running street legal vehicle must show proof of insurance upon registration This
 event is limited to 2wd cars, mini-vans, mid-size SUVS and mini-trucks. No fullsize trucks
 will be allowed. If RWD must have mud-flaps the extend to the ground from the
 wheel-well.
- Passengers will be allowed in the car division. Passengers must be over the age of 18.
 Passengers MUST wear helmet and seatbelt during the event. Passengers are not allowed in SxS division or with driver under the age of 18 other than parent/guardian.
- Any tire will be allowed as long its holds air. Vehicles must have working breaks No alcohol allowed in the pits.
- Slogans, advertising and other signage is allowed but must no contain profanity or offensive imagery.
- Registration for this event will begin at 4pm on both days and run until 30 minutes prior to show time. Drivers meeting approx. 20 minutes before the start of event.
- All vehicles must be removed from the infield within 48 hours of the conclusion of the event. Anything remaining after 48 hours becomes property of the Lake of the Woods County Fair board.
