Fishing for the Fair Ice Fishing Tournament Rules:

- 1) All participants must have a valid Minnesota fishing license at the time of registration if 16 years or older.
- 2) Contest starts at 2:00 pm and ends at 4:30 pm with the sound of a horn.
- 3) All participants must follow Minnesota fishing regulations, there will be no northern registered between 30 and 40 inches or no walleye registered over 19.5.
- 4) All fish measured and photographed must be alive. Frozen or dead fish will not be allowed. The measuring officials will return all fish caught to the river.
- 5) Live bait is allowed in the contest.
- 6) Bait will not be sold on the river.
- 7) Contestants are not allowed to set up a fish house in the area of the contest.
- 8) There will be no ATV's or snowmobiles allowed within the fishing area for contestants.
- 9) Holes will be pre-drilled; you must use the holes that are in the fishing area.
- 10) Contestants will only be allowed to fish with one line.
- 11) No fish will be allowed to be registered after the contest has ended, which is at 4:30 pm
- 12) All prizes are determined by largest length and time registered. In case of a tie with the weight, the first fish registered wins.
- 13) You must fish in the designated area and have a button on at all times.
- 14) Participants must act and behave in an orderly manner and are responsible for their actions.
- 15) Pre-fishing is allowed but all the lines must be out of the water by 1:45 pm.
- 16) Handicap parking will be available on the ice.
- 17) Fishing for the Fair officials reserve the right to disqualify any participant that they think may be cheating in anyway.
- 18) All contestants participate in the contest at their own risk.
- 19) Cash drawings (need not be present) will be held at the VFW Club at 7pm during the dinner.
