

## Review - segmenting for spelling

Go to the 'Segmenting' tab to access segmenting for spelling activities.



- Say a CVC word (e.g. pig)
  and, holding up three fingers,
  sound-talk it (e.g. p i g),
  pointing to a finger at a time
  for each phoneme.
- Ask the children to do the same and watch to check that they are correct.



- Holding up the three fingers on one hand, drag the letters of the word into the phoneme frame.
- Say another word and ask the children to sound-talk it using their fingers.
- 5. Ask them to sound-talk it in chorus for you to write it.
- 6. Ask them to sound-talk (with fingers) more words that you say.
- 7. Practise: Use the same sequence of instructions with children at their desks as they write the word on phoneme frames or use magnetic letters as appropriate.
