

# house rules cont.

#### NO PARTIES

Please no parties or events allowed unless pre-approved by hosts. All parties and events must be arranged by hosts at an additional fee or an approved event planner. Per Airbnb, until further notice, gatherings of more than 16 people—including both overnight guests and visitors—are not allowed, regardless of Host authorization.

### NO ADDITIONAL OVERNIGHT GUESTS

People other than those in the Guest party set forth in your reservation may not stay overnight at the property. Guests are not allowed to exceed the occupancy limit agreed to. Any additional guest discovered will be subject to an additional guest fee of \$25 USD per guest.

#### NO SMOKING

Please no smoking of any kind on the property (cigarettes, cigars, vape pen, etc.). If signs of smoking are discovered you will be required to pay a smoking fine of \$250 USD.

### NO PETS

Please know, we love animals, but we take pet allergies seriously. No pets allowed. If pets are discovered you will be required to pay a pet fine of \$250 USD.

#### NO LINEN DAMAGE

Please do not dye your hair on the property or use white linens to clean your makeup off. We have provided black makeup towels for makeup removal. Any signs of hair dye or makeup damage discovered on the linens will require you to pay a linen fine of \$50 USD to replace.

wifi/streaming

There is wifi and smart TVs in the home to stream from your favorite networks. Use the remote to sign-in to your personal account or select the AirBnB Guest account.

Please do not unplug the modem box in the bedroom (front of the house) This will disrupt the signal and the internet will not work.



# air conditioning/heat

The thermostat is located behind the TV in the living room. Adjust the temperature as you please but DO NOT lower past 68 Degrees as this will damage the unit.

Each room is equipped with a fan in case the rooms get warm in the summer months. The remotes on the wall control the fan speed and dim the room lights. The light switch must be turned on for the remote to work.

# the kitchen

The kitchen is fully stocked with coffee, tea, spices and light breakfast items. Please feel free to use them all, they are provided for your enjoyment.

All kitchen appliances, tools, utensils, and gadgets are available for you to use. Please only use for their intended purpose.





the trash

Upon checkout, please throw away all garbage in the trash or recycling bin located in the kitchen and bathrooms.

If staying for an extended period of time, the garbage removal day is Tuesday. The garbage and recycling bins are located in the backyard, next to the shed near the back wall.

# the bathroom

The bathroom is stocked with bathroom toiletries and emergency personal hygiene items.

Please do not flush foreign objects, napkins, or personal hygiene products down the toilet. Use the trash bin provided to dispose.





The linens

Please inform us of any damage to linens or towels. Clear and speedy communication will allow us to remedy the situation in a timely manner.

All beds are prepared with fresh clean linens with the highest standard of cleanliness and comfort. You will be provided with clean towels for each guest included in your reservation. For additional towels or linens please reach out to hosts.

# The security

The security system panel is located on the table next to the bulletin board in the kitchen and is operated by ADT Security. The system will NOT be armed during your stay.

Security cameras are located on the front porch and back patio. When the front/back door or windows are opened, or sudden loud noise sounds, the security system will chime. The front doorbell has a security camera.





The laundry

The washer & dryer are available for you to use to clean your clothes. Please remember to remove all clothes from units before checking out.

#### Washer:

- 1. Press the power button to turn on
- 2. Turn knob to select the type of washing cycle
- 3. Press the play button to begin cycle

### Dryer:

- 1. Press the type of drying cycle
- 2. Press and hold the start button to begin cycle

If any furniture was moved, replace it to it's original location




