The Florida Society, Children of the American Revolution, is a state society of the National Society, Children of the American Revolution (C.A.R.). The National Society C.A.R. was founded in 1895 by Harriet M. Lothrop, famous author and Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) member, to instill pride and patriotism in the future leaders of America—the children.

Over a century later, the organization remains the oldest patriotic youth organization in America. Boys or girls ages 21 years and younger are eligible for membership in the National Society, Children of the American Revolution, if they are lineally descended from a man or woman who rendered material aid with unfailing loyalty to the cause of American independence as a soldier, sailor, civil officer, or recognized patriot in one of the several Colonies, or of the United States.

- *Historic preservation of important events associated with the independence of America;*
- *Honor memories of those who rendered service in the American Revolution;*
- *Promote the celebration of patriotic anniversaries;*

- *Love, honor, and extend the principles of American liberty and patriotism*
