Applicants must also provide the following information:

1) A brief essay of what the Florida Society Children of the American Revolution has meant to you and the contributions you have made to the Florida Society Children of the American Revolution (*150 -200 words*).

2) A list of your involvement in the Local, State, and National Societies, including dates of participation for the following: office(s), chairmanship(s), conference(s), convention(s), regional meetings, local society meetings, special events and/or projects of note.

3) A Brief Essay of your future plans (*100 -150 words*).

4) High School resume including extracurricular and community activities.
