

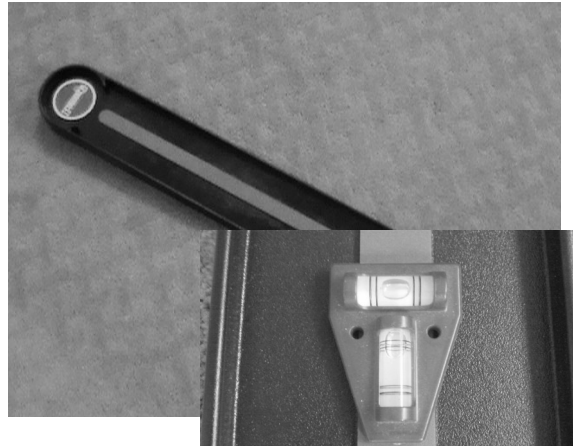

Decide which side of the Putting Alley<sup>®</sup> isolator to use. The device has a one inch alley and one half inch alley on opposite sides.



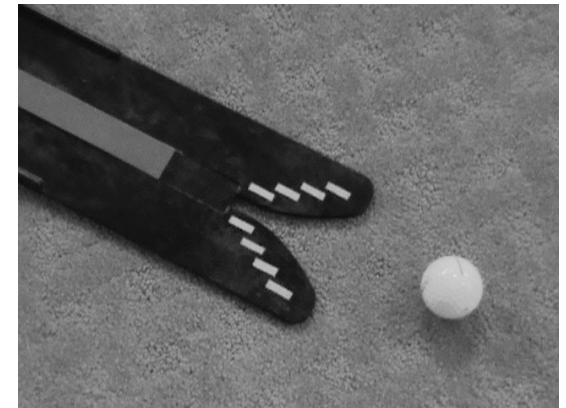

Lay the Putting Alley<sup>®</sup> on a flat level surface. Use a level to make sure the Alley is horizontally level.



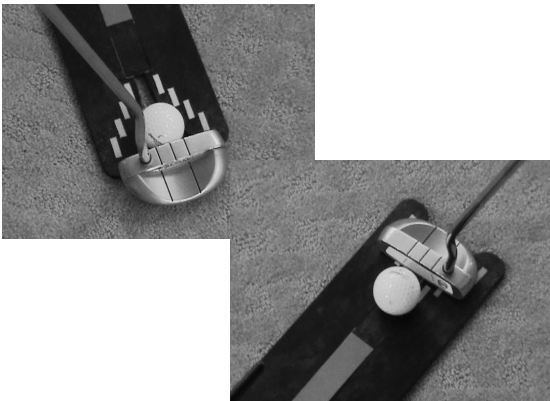

Drop a ball in front of The Putting Alley<sup>®</sup> isolator.

Use your putter to load the ball into the starting area by pushing the ball through the open slot until it drops onto the front of the Alley.

Make sure the ball is centered on the Alley. If necessary, use your putter to nudge the ball and it will self center.

Ready to make a stroke. Putt the ball all the way on the alley to the Putting Alley<sup>®</sup> logo for a successful putt. →

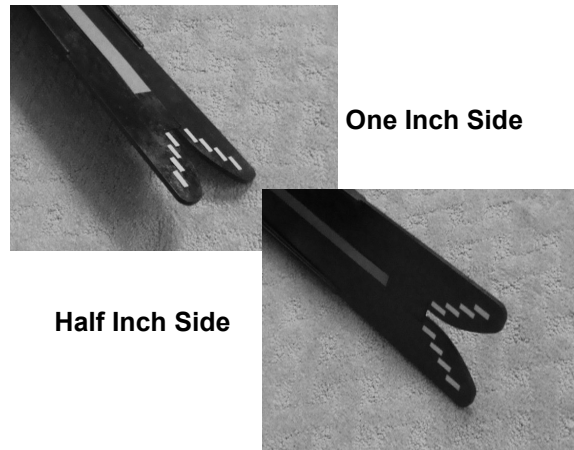

Whether the ball holes out or misses short, the ball will return back to you.



Simply flip the device to go from one level of difficulty to the other.

Let the ball come all the way out of the device to the front, and you are ready to load the ball for the next stroke.
