
For the Books Triple Bridge Fun Fold Card

Supplies:

- Stamp Set/Bundle: For the Books Bundle (164843), Country Birdhouse (163395)
- Cardstock: Basic White (159276), Early Espresso (119686), Pecan Pie (161717), Daffodil Delight (119683)
- Ink: Early Espresso (147114)
- Tools & Accessories: Subtles Stampin' Write Markers (161698), Neutrals Stampin' Write Markers (161697), Brights Stampin' Write Markers (161696), Regals Stampin' Write Markers (161699), 2024-2026 In Color Stampin' Write Markers (163829), Country Woods DSP (163393), Adhesive-Backed Speckled Dots (162191), Gold Twisted Thread (164603), Take Your Pick (144107), Bone Folder (102300), Paper Trimmer (152392), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334), Clear Block D (118485), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Tear & Tape Adhesive (154031), Paper Snips Scissors (103579)

Measurements:

- Country Woods DSP: 4" x 12", scored at ¾", 1 ¾", 2 ¾", and 3 ¾" from each end on the 12" side
- Early Espresso cardstock: 1" x 4 ½" (2 pieces), ½" x 4 ½"
- Pecan Pie cardstock: 7/8" x 4 ½" (2 pieces), 3/8" x 4 ½"
- Basic White cardstock: Scrap for stamping
- Daffodil Delight: Scrap for die cutting tassle

Instructions:

- Create your fun fold card base with the piece of scored 4" x 12" Country Woods DSP. Burnish all score lines as valley folds. This will help shape the square columns on each end. Add a strip of Tear & Tape to the area between the end of the paper and the ¾" score line. Hold the end at the 1 ¾" score line, fold the end at the 3 ¾" score line to make the column lie flat on the DSP. This will adhere the ¾" part to the DSP to create the column. Repeat on the other end.
- Stamp the two 7/8" x 4 ½" Pecan Pie pieces of cardstock (as pictured) with Early Espresso ink. The "happy birthday" sentiment is from the Country Birdhouse stamp set. The "this one's for the books" sentiment is from the For the Books stamp set.
- Adhere the three pieces of Pecan Pie cardstock to the three pieces of Early Espresso cardstock, as pictured.
- Adhere the layered (Pecan Pie and Early Espresso) pieces to the columns. It is easier to adhere these pieces by putting the multipurpose glue onto the columns rather than the cardstock. You may want to put an "X" on the part of the column where the glue will go as a visual reminder.
- Use the scrap of Basic White cardstock, Early Espresso ink, and a block to stamp the book images.
- Color your book images with your choices of Stampin' Write Markers. For the example, I used the following colors – Azure Afternoon, Crumb Cake, Crushed Curry, Granny Apple Green, Lemon Lolly, Pecan Pie, and Summer Splash. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to fussy cut the book images.
- Dry fit your fussy cut book images to figure out where you would like them on your card.
- Die cut the tassel from the For the Books Dies from Daffodil Delight cardstock. Before you start
 rolling the tassel together, use a glue dot to secure the end of a piece of Gold Twisted Thread to
 the end of the die cut tassel. Roll the tassel up. Secure the open end with another glue dot.
 Cut the Gold Twisted Thread to the desired length. Attach the open end of the thread behind
 the fussy cut book image.
- Adhere your book images to the card as you would like.
- To keep the tassel secure, figure out where you would like it to be on the card. Put a glue dot on that spot to adhere the tassel.
- Add a few Adhesive-Backed Speckled Dots to finish your card.
- This triple bridge fun fold card will fit into a regular A2 envelope. If the tassel causes an issue with the envelope, consider cutting the tassel die in half to make the diameter smaller.
