[ecycleNYC](#) in-building program is a free and convenient recycling service provided by DSNY and ERI. Electronics are recycled domestically following the strictest industry and environmental standards. Plus, it's safe: As part of this recycling process, all data will be fully erased. These types of products can be recycled:

- TVs;
- VCRs, DVRs, and DVD players;
- Cable and satellite boxes;
- Video game consoles;
- Computers, including small servers, monitors, laptops and their peripherals, such as keyboards, hard drives, mice, etc.;
- Printers and scanners;
- Fax machines; and
- Small electronics, including tablets, mobile phones and MP3 players.

[Appliances](#), [batteries](#), and [light bulbs](#) are **not accepted** in the [ecycleNYC](#) program.

Buildings with 100 or more Units: Management stores the residents' old electronics in a locked bin provided by [ecycleNYC](#).

When it's time for a pick-up, a building manager or staff member can call (212) 437-4647 or email ecycleNYC@dsny.nyc.gov. Pick-up is guaranteed within five business days.
