BATTERIES

- Alkaline Batteries (AA, AAA, C, D); Please remove all batteries and dispose of them in the trash.
- Rechargeable, button type/rechargeable Nickel cadmium (nicad), Lithium ion (rechargeable), Lithium metal (non-rechargeable) and mercury batteries MAY NOT be disposed of in the trash or recycle dumpsters.

The township separates metal, loose paper, books, magazines, food cartons, and cardboard. It is not mandatory that residents separate these items. If you do have large quantities, or separate items at home however, **please see the attendant on duty** for proper recycling of the items at the waste site. By doing so, the town receives reimbursement to offset the costs of waste management.

- o Bring all cardboard(boxes) into the recycle center to be placed in the baler. **See attendant**
- Mixed paper/books/catalogs/loose paper: See attendant
- Metal/aluminum cans: See attendant.
- **CLOTHING ITEMS**: Do not place in trash, please recycle at St. Vincent DePaul.
- Waste Oil and filters ARE accepted at the Recycle Center See attendant.

THE FOLLOWING <u>ARE NOT</u> TO BE DISPOSED IN DUMPSTERS PLEASE FOLLOW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DISPOSAL

- Yard Waste/Ashes from burning consider composting. The WI DNR is a resource you can use to learn more about composting. City of Watertown Yard Waste site.
- **Hazardous Waste**: enamel & oil based paint, pesticides, kerosene, gasoline, antifreeze, household chemicals, varnish, paint thinner, paint stripping chemicals, other automotive fluids and cleaners, lithium batteries, items containing mercury, etc. Clean sweep event.
- Medication Clean sweep event
- **LP Tanks** return to retailer
- Lawn mower (all types), other small engine items: Contact American Disposal, 807 Elm St. Wttn.

Dodge County hosts "Clean Sweep" events annually.

- Metal conduit must be cut into 4 ft lengths
- Plastic conduit or PVC (hard plastic), gray in color must be cut into 4ft lengths.
 - If the attendant on duty has to cut pipes to required length there is a \$10 fee assessed.
- If attendant on duty has to remove batteries from items there is a \$10 fee assessed.

Town of Emmet Ordinance #17

It is unlawful for any person to collect or remove any recyclable material that has been deposited in a recycling drop off container. Recyclable materials deposited at the Town of Emmet site is property of the Town of Emmet.

Any authorized officer, employee, or representative of the Town of Emmet, including a duly authorized town police officer, may inspect recyclable materials separated for recycling, and post-consumer waste intended for disposal.
