## THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE TO BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLING DUMPSTERS

Recyclable	Required Preparation	Restrictions
<b>PLASTIC CONTAINERS: #1 - #7</b> Water, soda, juice or drink bottles Yogurt containers Cottage cheese containers and lids Salad dressing, catsup, mayo, syrup & condiment containers Peanut butter jars Milk containers Detergent bottles	Containers must be rinsed and free of debris Remove bottle pumps and dispose as trash Milk containers should be flattened to conserve space Check for recycle symbol Plastic rings and caps need not be removed	<b>NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY TYPE</b> are to be placed in the dumpster – this includes: Store bags, produce or bread bags, case wrap or storage bags. Consider recycling by taking to store drop sites. <b>NO</b> straws, plastic silverware or plastic toys <b>NO</b> styrofoam or packaging materials <b>NO</b> motor oil or gas containers
<b>PAPER</b> Newspapers & magazines Junk mail, cards and office paper Books, paperbacks, phone books Paper bags	Paper must be loose or in a paper bag – <b>NO Plastic bags, twine, tape or string</b> Kept dry if possible	<b>NO</b> shredded paper <b>NO</b> paper cups
<b>CARTONS (with laminated coating)</b> Milk, juice, egg, drink, soup, ice cream cartons	Containers must be rinsed and free of debris Cartons should be flattened to conserve space	
<b>GLASS BOTTLES &amp; JARS</b> Sauce, spice or other food jars Alcohol or drink bottles	Containers must be rinsed and free of debris  All colors of glass are acceptable	Glass <b>DOES NOT</b> include: lightbulbs of any kind, Pyrex or heat resistant glassware, crystal, ceramic dishes or pottery, mirrors or window glass.
<b>STEEL &amp; ALUMINUM</b> Soup, vegetable, coffee, beverage, fruit and pet food cans Disposable aluminum baking pans Aluminum foil (must be clean)	Containers must be rinsed and free of debris	<b>NO</b> aerosol cans or paint cans – these items are household trash or you may recycle on your own

## RECYCLE BUILDING

Material	Required Preparation	Restrictions
<b>CARDBOARD</b> Food products boxes- cereal/cake/cracker; Corrugated cardboard; Toilet paper and towel rolls; Kleenex boxes	Must be clean and free of food debris Flatten boxes if possible Remove all packing materials before disposal	<b>NO</b> cartons with laminated coating: ice cream, milk, juice – these may be disposed in the recycle dumpster

Waste oil will continue to be handled in the recycle building.
