

# **PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING**

## **RECONSTRUCTION OF APPLE ROAD BRIDGE OVER SILVER CREEK TOWN OF EMMET**

**November 24, 2020  
6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

The reconstruction of the Apple Road Bridge over Silver Creek will be discussed at a public involvement meeting scheduled by the Town of Emmet and Dodge County in Wisconsin.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Emmet town hall located at W6777 Second Street Road, Watertown, WI 53098. The meeting will also have a link available on the Town website (<https://emmettownship.com/>) to attend virtually. Residents are encouraged to attend via whichever format works best for them.

The Town will relocate and replace the existing bridge with a new single-span concrete flat slab bridge and reconstruct the roadway approaches on Apple Road over Silver Creek located in Section 2 in the Town of Emmet, Dodge County, Wisconsin. Work will consist of bridge removal, grading, roadway obliteration, concrete masonry, crushed aggregate base course, asphalt pavement, erosion control items, and landscaping items.

During construction, Apple Road will remain open to traffic.

Work is scheduled to take place in the summer of 2022.

The purpose of the meeting is to present the preliminary plans of the work scheduled for the bridge construction project, discuss the proposed schedule, and gather public input. Any comments that may be of interest to the design team are welcome.

The meeting will be organized in an open-house format and interested persons are invited to attend at their convenience. There will be a presentation at the onset to provide an overview of the projects followed by questions. Representatives from the Town of Emmet and Ayres Associates will be available to discuss the design details, address comments, and answer questions. Displays showing the proposed projects will be available for viewing.

Persons with a concern or knowledge about historic buildings and structures, public lands, and archaeological sites are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the Town of Emmet.
