- Please do not bring items to the recycle center and leave for others to take for free. If you have something you believe is of interest to others, please donate it to St. Vincent DePaul or Able Light Thrift stores.
- Should you place items out for "free" at your place of residence/business, please ensure that the items are not left out for an unreasonable amount of time. Unattended items found to be left out for an unreasonable period of time or a resident complaint is received said owner of the property will be contacted and asked to remove the items. If the Town of Emmet must remove items from said property because of interference with maintenance, or found in the ROW or ditch of said property, the owner of the property will be invoiced for the cost of removal and disposal and may be turned over to the local authorities.

• CLOTHING ITEMS should be taken to St. Vincent DePaul or Able Light Thrift Stores for proper recycling or reselling.

# THE FOLLOWING <u>ARE NOT</u> TO BE DISPOSED IN DUMPSTERS PLEASE FOLLOW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DISPOSAL

- Yard Waste consider composting. The WI DNR is a resource you can use to learn more about composting.
- Hazardous Waste: enamel & oil based paint, pesticides, kerosene, gasoline, antifreeze, household
  chemicals, varnish, paint thinner, paint stripping chemicals, other automotive fluids and cleaners,
  lithium batteries, items containing mercury, etc.
- Medication
- LP Tanks (DO NOT dispose in scrap trailer or the trash dumpster)

#### THE FOLLOWING MAY BE DISPOSED IN HOUSEHOLD TRASH DUMPSTERS

Please consider other options before disposing in the trash

- PLASTIC BAGS AND WRAP ARE RECYCLABLE While they are not allowed in the Recycle Dumpster, you can take them to a retailer near you and deposit in bins provided. Walmart, Kohls and Pick N Save are a few of the local retailers that have bins available.
- WORN OUT CLOTHING AND TEXTILES ARE RECYLABLE If you have items that are too worn to donate or sell, you can recycle them. If you take them to St. Vincent DePaul, for example, just let the attendant know that the items are not in saleable condition. They will place them in their recycle trailer and receive a cash benefit from recycling them.
