### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE TO BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLING DUMPSTERS

Recyclable	Required Preparation
<ul> <li>PLASTIC CONTAINERS: #1 - #7</li> <li>Water, soda, juice or drink bottles</li> <li>Yogurt containers</li> <li>Cottage cheese containers and lids</li> <li>Salad dressing, catsup, mayo, syrup &amp; condiment containers</li> <li>Peanut butter jars</li> <li>Milk containers</li> <li>Detergent bottles</li> <li>Ice Cream pails</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Containers must be rinsed and free of debris</li> <li>Remove bottle pumps and dispose as trash</li> <li>Milk containers should be flattened to conserve space</li> <li>Check for recycle symbol</li> <li>Plastic rings and caps need not be removed</li> </ul>
PAPER <ul> <li>Newspapers &amp; magazines</li> <li>Junk mail, cards and office paper</li> <li>Books, paperbacks, phone books</li> <li>Paper bags</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Paper must be loose or in a paper bag NO Plastic bags, twine, tape or string</li> <li>Kept dry if possible</li> </ul>
CARTONS (with laminated coating) Milk, juice, egg, drink, soup, ice cream cartons	<ul> <li>Containers must be rinsed and free of debris</li> <li>Cartons should be flattened to conserve space</li> </ul>
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS <ul> <li>Sauce, spice or other food jars</li> <li>Alcohol or drink bottles</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Containers must be rinsed and free of debris</li> <li>All colors of glass are acceptable</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>STEEL &amp; ALUMINUM</li> <li>Soup, vegetable, coffee, beverage, fruit and pet food cans</li> <li>Disposable aluminum baking pans</li> <li>Aluminum foil (must be clean)</li> </ul>	Containers must be rinsed and free of debris

## The following are NOT ALLOWED in the RECYCLE dumpster(s)

NO PLASTIC BAGS of ANY TYPENO AEROSOL or PAINT cansNO STRAWSNO PLASTIC service ware (forks, knives, spoons, etc.NO PLASTIC TOYSNO STYROFOAM (packing Styrofoam or other platic packing materials)NO MOTOR OILNO GAS CONTAINERSNO PAPER CUPSNO SHREDDED PAPERNO LIGHTBULBS of ANY TYPENO Pyrex dishes/bowls, etc.NO Crystal bowls, vases, etc.NO MIRRORSNO WINDOW GLASS

### **RECYCLE BUILDING** Please see the attendant for the following items:

- Corrugated boxes should be flattened and given to the attendant for placement in the baler. (Persons under 18 are not allowed to place cardboard in the baler)
- All packing material must be removed from moving/storage boxes.
- No cartons with a laminated coating are to be baled. These items go in the recycle dumpster.
- WASTE OIL & Waste oil filters (no fuel oil, gasoline, antifreeze or other automotive fluids) Waste oil will continue to be handled in the recycle building. Please check with the attendant.

If any resident is found to have left automotive waste fuel, e.g. gasoline, antifreeze, or automotive batteries etc. at the trash/recycle site the resident will be contacted to return to pick up the item(s). If the matter is not addressed promptly the matter will be turned over to the local authorities as well as be invoiced for the cost of disposal.
