



CODE OF CONDUCT

1. PURPOSE OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to establish a safe, respectful, supportive and disciplined school environment in which every learner can learn, develop and participate fully in school life. The Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected from all learners and provides guidelines for maintaining good discipline, mutual respect and responsibility within the school community. The Code applies to learners during school hours, on school property. While travelling to or from school where their behaviour is connected to the school. During school activities, excursions, camps, sporting events and cultural activities. When representing the school. during any activity or communication that may affect the safety, reputation or wellbeing of the school community, including appropriate online conduct.

2. SCHOOL VALUES

Respect – Treating oneself, others and school property with dignity.

Responsibility – Taking ownership of one's actions, duties and choices.

Integrity – Being honest, trustworthy and accountable.

Kindness – Treating others with care, consideration and compassion.

Excellence – Making a genuine effort to achieve one's best.

Discipline – Following reasonable rules and making responsible choices.

Inclusivity – Respecting differences and ensuring that everyone feels welcome and valued.

Safety – Acting in ways that protect oneself and others.

3. LEARNER RESPONSIBILITIES

Attend school regularly and arrive on time.

Attend all scheduled lessons and activities.

Complete homework, assignments and projects.

Bring the required books, stationery and equipment to school.

Listen attentively and participate positively in lessons.

Follow reasonable instructions from teachers and authorised school staff.

Treat all members of the school community with respect.

Take care of school property and facilities.

Maintain appropriate personal hygiene and appearance.

Behave responsibly on school grounds and during school activities.

Report serious incidents, bullying, threats or unsafe behaviour to an appropriate adult.

Accept responsibility for their actions and make efforts to correct inappropriate behaviour.

Personal appearance and conduct.

The following are not acceptable:

Insults and name-calling. Swearing directed at another person. Threatening behaviour. Intimidation. Harassment. Discriminatory or hateful language. Deliberate humiliation of another person. Fighting or encouraging others to fight. Attend school every day unless there is a valid reason for absence. Cyber and digital mis conduct. Bullying and harassment. Possession of prohibited items and substances.
