





Objective:

(1) Develop advanced skills in using Computer Assisted Audit Tools (CAATs) and other relevant technologies.

(2) Enhance problem-solving skills and the ability to analyze complex audit scenarios.(3) Provide opportunities for students to connect with industry professionals and potential employers.

(4) Familiarize students with the latest Al tools, platforms, and frameworks used in the industry.

Participants:

Each university can nominate team(s) of three students to participate. Teams should be led by a faculty, who will be the main contact for the team(s).

Pre-Competition Training

For student groups with limited experience with audit analytics, we offer free online training session on CAATs & AI (e.g., ACL, JCAATs, IDEA etc) before the competition.

Deliverables: Each team will solve six audit objectives in four hours **Judges:** There will be three professional judges

Prize for each group:

(1) Cash prize: \$1,000 for the 1st place team(2) Ranking scheme will be based on the number of the earliest solved problems

(1) Teams can use any Computer Assisted Audit Tools(2) It is open resources contest
