8. Participate in lifelong learning regarding the practice of their profession.
9. Assist audit team members in professional development and become more audit efficient.
10. Promote public knowledge of computer auditing.

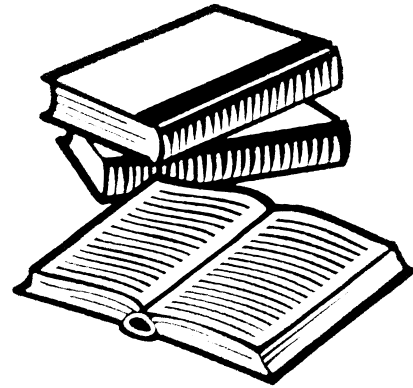

Knowledge Inventory

The Knowledge Inventory component of the exam counts for 60 percent of the final grade. It is meant to test your familiarity with professional knowledge and analysis of practical application. The exam consists of multiple choice covering these topics:

1. Frameworks and Standards
2. Auditing and GHG Accounting
3. Report and Assurance
4. CAATs and Greenwashing

Case Study

The Case Study component of the exam counts for 40 percent of the final grade. It is meant to test your familiarity with CAATs and auditing skills. The exam consists of fill in the blank, and short answer questions covering three topics:

- Smart Auditing for Environment
- Smart Auditing for Social
- Smart Auditing for Governance

Exam

This closed-book, 240 minutes-long certification exams is divided into two components:

a Knowledge Inventory and an ESG computer auditing case study.

The case study is CAATs free independent. You can use any CAATs, such as JCAATs, ACL, IDEA etc., to attend the exam.

Examination Fee

The ICEA certification exam fee is US \$470. All registrations are final, and no refunds are possible. You will receive your ICEA certificate within one month after passing the comprehensive exam.
