NORCAL ELECTION OF OFFICERS 2025



For the first time in over four years, the NorCal Board of Directors met at the Berkeley Community Theatre on January 25th and elected officers for 2025. During COVID pandemic and reconstruction of the stage house and the adjacent high school building, the board met every two months using Internet conferencing hosted by Kevin King or Chris Booras.

THE WIND IS ON!



Also on January 25th, we completed the installation of the blowers in the basement blower room and turned each of them on. In our October Windsheet, we stated that expected to have the operational by the end of the month.

However, the majority of the weekends since then, the theatre has not been available for us to work. It has been over four years since there has been wind on the organ and there was a lot of dust and humidity created in the process of rebuilding the stage house. There were assorted ciphers primarially in the center chamber, and as yet unsurveyed dead notes through out the organ, but the crew is excited to have the wind on and to be able to work on correcting problems on a "live" organ. You passed the test if you noticed that the inlet ducts were not yet installed on the blowers when the picture was taken.

The new Uniflex 4000 computer uses Cat-5 cable instead of "flat ribbon" cable, so the new cable had to be routed from the relay room at chamber level down to the new computer cabinet at stage level, and to the two console connection locations on the orchestra elevator. This was accomplished some months ago. Chris Nichols brought over the new Uniflex computer (which was donated to Nor-Cal by Bill Schlotter) on Saturday, February 22nd. Also, on the 22nd, Ted Hubbard re-installed the wiring which enables the blowers to be turned on and off from the computer cabinet at stage level or from the main chambers. There will be numerious times when Kevin is tuning or setting prssures, that he will want the wind to be on or off, and it is a long way down to the blower room!
