### NORCAL WURLITZER AT BCT - PROGRESS

The two blowers are located in a basement room at stage right. Part of the seismic strengthening work at BCT involved enlarging the foundations under part of the blower room floor. To make way for this work, the NorCal organ crew removed the blowers and windlines to temporary storage at the back of the main floor of the theatre. The contractor was quite helpful in our efforts.

We were able to start work on the organ in the Fall. The original new computer cabinet at stage right has been replaced and a new, fiber-optic cable to the chambers is being installed. There is some work to be done in the pipe chambers before a major re-tuning job.

The NorCal organ crew started re-installing the blowers late in the Fall with the first blower in place on Saturday, December 10. Blower No. 2 was installed on Saturday, January 20.

The blowers still need to be connected to the large wind line leading up to the pipe chambers and the blower motors still need to be connected to both electricity and the stop/start control buttons.

<u>Chris Nichols writes</u>: The gang met for a work session today (Saturday, January 20.). We got the second blower assembled. The 20 HP motor is very heavy. The other parts are moderately awkward to

handle. Aligning the wind line and blower parts was a bit time consuming. Great job, guys!

We had two crews working on on Saturday, January 21st. Chris, Jud, and Ted pulled the new ethernet and microphone wires through the conduit between the upstairs relay room and the control cabinet at stage level. Kevin, Neal, Rudy, and Wayne were at work in the blower room positioning duct work, cleaning the walls, and finishing the bolting up of one of the blowers.

Work scheduled for Saturday, February 3 will be running power lines from the relay room to the stage level cabinet, doing more blower duct work, and continuing cleaning.

### **BOARD ELECTION**

At the December 2 Board meeting it was reported that two written and signed letters of nomination were received. They were for Rudy Frey and Ted Hubbard. On a motion made by Chris Booras and seconded by Kevin King, the two were declared elected for three-year terms for the calendar years 2024 through 2026.
