Francis Cooke arrived in the Mayflower in 1620. He built the third house in Plymouth Colony. He was the 17th signer of the Mayflower Compact at Cape Cod 11/11/1620. Francis Cooke was born in England in 1582 and he died at Plymouth, Mass. 04/07/1663.
