REVOLUTIONARY WAR SOLDIER'S GRAVE

Hezekiah Adkins (1759-1842)
and his wife Mary Levon (1768-
1855) buried nearby. He served
under Captain John Lucas as a
private in Montgomery County
militia. Claimed service on New
River against Native Americans
and in guarding wagons of lead
from Virginia mines. Settled
near Bowens Creek circa 1810.
