Captain William R. Gunu's Company was transferred to the 8th Regiment Virginia Cavalry and became (2d) Company D of that organization. The other six companies were consolidated with four companies of Major Caldwell's Battalion Virginia Cavalry, January 15, 1803, and formed the 16th Regiment Virginia Cavalry. †Roll indorsed: "Rec'd (A. & I. G. O.) Feb. 10, 1863."
