*This company subsequently became Captain Ferguson's Company, Ferguson's Battalion Virginia Cavalry.

Ferguson's Battalion Virginia Cavalry (also called the Guyandotte Battalion) appears to have been an unorganized command composed of seven companies which were formed on various dates between August 4, 1862, and January 12, 1863. Captain William R. Gunn's Company was transferred to the 8th Regiment Virginia Cavalry and became (2d) Company D of that organization. The other six companies were consolidated with four companies of Major Caldwell's Battalion Virginia Cavalry, January 15, 1863, and formed the 16th Regiment Virginia Cavalry.
