Maston Morrison Sansom, 96, formerly of Chillicothe, residing in Ballston Lake, New

York, passed away suddenly Saturday afternoon, December 27, 2003.

Maston spent most of his life in Chilicothe, although he was born in Wayne, WV to the late Andrew and Amanda Sansom on August 27, 1907. Maston had one surviving sister, Mrs. Mildred Yaple, of Columbus. His sisters, Elizabeth Talbot and Ethel DeFeu and brother Andrew Sansom predeceased him. He is honored by 14 grandchildren, six great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.
