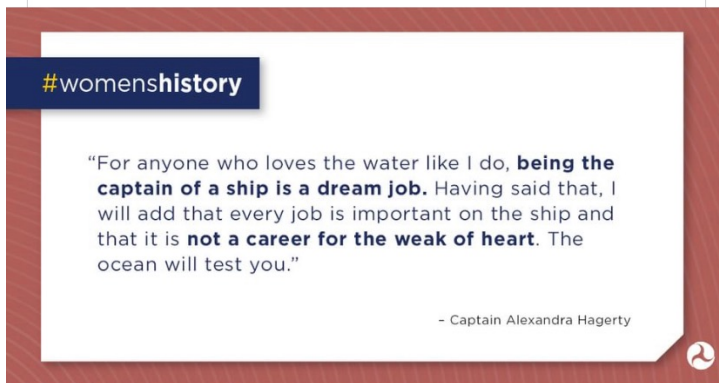

Hagerty, who sails as chief officer aboard the USNS Bowditch, has spoken at Aspen High School in Colorado about her sailing career, and addressed the pursuit of careers in the maritime industry as part of the Aspen Institute's High Seas Initiative. She is also a representative for North America on the Younger Member's Council of the Nautical Institute.
