### **Market Day**

### Market Day is scheduled for March 21, 2026, 9-4 with set up on Mar 20th

Currently 19 paid vendors representing 24 booths. Leigh Ann will email vendors who had a booth in 2025 but have not contacted us yet to see if they want a booth in 2026. Louise Harris and Victoria Lowe were added as admins on the Go Daddy website. Louise looked into the cost of upgrading the site so we could do online registrations and accept payments for membership and classes. The cost is \$44.99/month (\$538.88 annually). Once you opt for the paid site you cannot revert to the free site. Also, the guild will be charged 2.7% plus \$0.30 per transaction so the cost to us for each student signing up online is \$1.38 (Example: 6 classes with 12 students each would cost \$72 in fees).

**Decided**: Not worth the money at this time.

Louise set up a guild email address; blackswampsg@gmail.com. At this point it is being monitored by Louise and Leigh Ann. Market Day committee members were invited to add the address to their emails, but each person needs to set it up individually. If you would like to help monitor the emails, please let Louise know and she can share the password. We are bcc each other so we know when someone has responded and we

don't duplicate the response. **Decided:** We will place the vendor contract on the GoDaddy website for vendors to download, but they still need to mail the contract to Leigh Ann with payment. We can place class sign up forms on the website, but again, they need to be downloaded and mailed to Denise.

- Jackie wool felting

**Decided:** Susan and Denise to teach 2:00–5:00pm Friday afternoon while vendors set up. Two class sessions in am 9:30a to noon and two sessions 1:00 to 3:30p. Default price for class is \$40 which should include some take home materials. Teachers are donating their time, but they are being paid for materials and labor spent securing the materials. Teachers need to let the Market Day committee know how much they need for materials. Also teachers need to get a short bio (how long you've been practicing your craft and something about what students will learn and take home with them). That needs to be to Denise as soon as possible!!!

All available members are needed to set up 9:00am to noon on Friday, March 20. Please help us by keeping your schedule clear. You are then invited to join guild members for lunch at a restaurant.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- 1. The wool we had processed is now back and it is beautiful! We have 3 colors: gray; brown, and light brown. The wool will be used for guild demos and for teaching. The slivers for spinning currently lives in 5 totes in Leigh Ann's basement and the fiber for felting is at Deb Yeagle's. Leigh Ann is dividing the spinning fiber up into 4 oz bags for teaching and for selling.
- 2. The federal grant requested by Wolcott House from the Ohio Arts Council was denied. Still working on other grant possibilities.
- 3. Demo requests completed:

Wolcott House (Contact: Ruth) June 26, 9:00 to 3:00 Thursday fiber day. Demo of big loom in the house, 2 table top looms, spinning, and sewing. Louise taught spinning on a wheel, Ruth showed the big loom had a table top loom for the kids to try. Susan taught drop spindle and Denise led a hands-on session making pot holders on small looms.
