

Eligibility

- Be age 55+ and qualify for Long Term Services and Supports based on help needed with ADL's like bathing, dressing and mobility. Screenings available through your local PACE site.
 Able to remain safe at home
- Able to remain safe at nome with the support of PACE
- Live within a zip code
 serviced by a PACE program

Fees

PACE is funded through a unique arrangement between Medicaid and Medicare. For those eligible for Medicare and Medicaid – or Medicaid only – there may be no fee. If you are eligible for Medicare only, there is a monthly fee to enroll in a PACE program. If you do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid, private pay options are available.

To Enroll

Contact your nearest PACE center to learn more, set up an in-person meeting and complete a LTSS screening. PACE can meet you in your home or at the PACE center where you can see for yourself the great benefits of joining PACE.
