## Chuck by Angela Guthrie

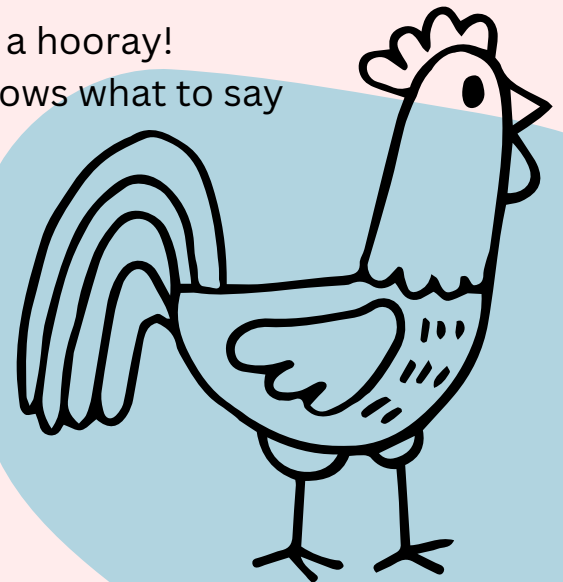
Chuck is a rooster who lives on a farm
