

Books-A-Million, Inc., also known as **BAM!**, is a bookstore chain in the United States, operating 260 stores in 32 states.^{III} Stores range in size from 4,000 to 30,000 square feet and sell books, magazines, manga, collectibles, toys, technology, and gifts.^{III} Most Books-A-Million stores feature "Joe Muggs" <u>cafes</u>, a coffee and espresso bar.^{III} Stores operate under the names Books-A-Million, Bookland, Books & Company, and 2nd & Charles.^{III}

The company owns Yogurt Mountain Holding, a <u>frozen yogurt</u> retailer and franchisor with 40 locations, as well as Preferred Growth Properties, which develops and manages commercial real estate investments.^{III} It owns and operates American Wholesale Book Company (AWBC), an e-commerce division operating as booksamillion.com; and an internet development and services company, NetCentral, in <u>Nashville</u>, Tennessee.^{III}

In December 2015, the company was acquired by its chairman, Clyde B. Anderson, and his family, for \$21 million.¹⁰¹⁰
